I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as "Confidential" as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 31 March 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 060" containing 13 items, "Pre-Trial Other package 005" containing 182 items and "Pre-Trial Other package 006" containing 55 items.

4. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 060" consists of documents from CAR Bureau Arc de l'Etat Major des Armes (Direction Generale du Renseignement Militaire), collected by the Prosecution, which are relevant to aspects of the chapeau elements of article 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute that are classified as incriminatory evidence.

5. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Other package 005" consists of documents from CAR Bureau Arc de l'Etat Major des Armes (Direction Generale du Renseignement Militaire), collected by the Prosecution. The Prosecution provides these items for the sake of completeness as part of its ongoing review of the evidence and under the legal classification of "Other" as they do not obviously include information material to the preparation of the Defence under rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

6. The disclosure of “Pre-Trial Other package 006” consists of witnesses documents,¹ which are relevant to aspects of the chapeau elements of articles 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute that are classified as Other. The Prosecution provides these items for the sake of completeness as part of its ongoing review of the evidence and under the legal classification of “Other” as they do not obviously include information material to the preparation of the Defence under rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
