I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as "Confidential" as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 7 April 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 061" containing 14 items, "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 027" containing 75 items and "Pre-Trial Other package 007" containing 305 items.

4. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 061" consists of materials that are relevant to aspects of the chapeau elements of article 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute which have been classified as incriminatory evidence. This package includes press articles, maps, communications, correspondence and reports.

5. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 027" consists of non-witness related evidence and includes press articles, reports, lists, audio video material and photographs, which are deemed material to the preparation of the Defence.

6. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Other package 007" consists of non-witness related evidence and includes press articles, reports, e-mail communications, correspondence, non-ICC statements, complaints, legislation, audio video material and photographs. The Prosecution provides these items for the sake of completeness as part of its ongoing review of the evidence and under the legal classification of

“Other” as they do not obviously include information material to the preparation of the Defence under rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
