SUBMISSIONS

1. The Defence for Mr Alfred Rombhot Yekatom ("Defence") hereby files this addendum to the "Yekatom Defence Response to the "Fifth Registry Report on the Implementation of the Restrictions on Contact for Mr Alfred Yekatom Ordered by Trial Chamber V" ("Response").¹
2. In its Response the Defence sought the re-addition of one of Mr Yekatom's family member to its list of non-privileged contacts, to support this request the Defence indicated that it reminded to the individual the rules that are to be respected while talking to Mr Yekatom and that the individual in question undertook to respect all of them.²
3. The Defence, due to the Easter holidays in the country where the family member is located and his very limited access to internet, only received the signed undertaking in the morning of 20 April 2022.
4. The Defence hereby provides the Chamber in Annex A a copy of the signed undertaking containing the rules that were reminded to the family member and his signed undertaking to respect all of them.

5. The annex to the present addendum is filed on a Confidential Ex Parte basis, only available to the Defence and the Registry, as it contains personal information in relation to Mr Yekatom's family.
