## **I. Introduction**

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber V (“Chamber”) of the appointment of Mr Sergei Golubok (“Mr Golubok”) as Legal Adviser to Witness P-2475 (“Notification of Appointment”), pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”).

## **II. Classification**

2. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the annexes to the present submission are classified as confidential, as they contain personal information and contact details of Mr Golubok.

## **III. Applicable Law**

3. The Registry has considered the following provisions: article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74 of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

## **IV. Submissions**

4. On 13 May 2022, the Chamber “[directed] the Registry to appoint duty counsel for P-2475 to advise the witness pursuant to Rule 74 of the Rules”,<sup>1</sup> upon request from the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecutor”).

5. On 18 May 2022, the Registrar appointed Mr Golubok as the Legal Adviser to Witness P-2475.<sup>2</sup> Mr Golubok will be duly provided with access to the relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of

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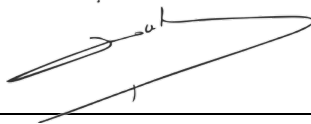

interviews of Witness P-2475, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain confidentiality at all times.<sup>3</sup>

6. On 18 May 2022, Mr Golubok executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.<sup>4</sup>

7. The Registrar remains at the disposal of the Chamber should further information be required.
