I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as confidential as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 30 May 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 072" containing 25 items and "Pre-Trial re-classification to INCRIM package 006" containing 14 items.

4. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 072" consists of materials which are relevant to the OCRB that are classified as incriminatory evidence.
