1. The Common Legal Representative of Victims (the “CLR”) files the present submission in accordance with the Order issued by Trial Chamber IX (the “Chamber”) on 16 January 2023, approving the Sample Application Forms and instructing, *inter alia*, the Legal Representatives of Victims to make submissions and complement the victims’ dossiers.¹

2. In particular, the CLR files Annex 1 containing a table on the eligibility assessment of the victims included in the Sample Application Forms and Annexes 2, 3 and 4 containing the resumptions of action of three deceased victims (namely, a/01608/16; a/01952/16 and a/02008/16). The CLR informs the Chamber that she recently had knowledge of the passing of another victim (a/01456/16). In this regard, the wife of the deceased victim intends to resume the action. However, it was not possible to collect all the necessary documentation for the resumption of action at the time of filing of this submission.

3. While the CLR was not able to obtain and provide additional documentation for all the victims included in the Sample Application Forms (except for victim a/07041/15 - provided a medical certificate), she files in Annexes 5, 6, 7 and 8 supplementary information containing more details about the crimes and harms suffered by victims a/07031/15; a/07041/15, a/07042/15 and a/07049/15.
