Dear Counsel and Registry:

The Prosecution requests to recognise 121 items as formally submitted (Email from the Prosecution, 18 February 2022, at 15:12) and the Defence requests that 51 items are recognised as formally submitted (Email from the Defence, 18 February 2022, 16:32).

On 21 February 2022, the Prosecution submitted a response to the Email of the Defence (Email from the Prosecution, 21 February 2022, at 15:46). Therein, it provides comments to a number of items and objects to the recognition as formally submitted of six items altogether and comments on a further one. The Defence did not provide a reply.

With regard to the items submitted by the Prosecution, the Chamber notes that the Defence does not oppose their recognition as formally submitted.

Further, the items constituting prior recorded testimony fulfil all the requirements of Rule 68(3) of the Rules and their introduction has been authorised by the Chamber (*see* ICC-01/09-01/20-223 and two oral decisions during the witness's testimony, T-050, page 31, lines 6 to 22; page 46, line 10 to page 47, line 19). The remainder of the items put forward for submission have been discussed in one form or another during the witnesses testimony. Accordingly, the Chamber recognises all items in the Prosecution's email as formally submitted.

With regard to the items submitted by the Defence, the Chamber notes the Prosecution's comment that a number of items have also been included in the Prosecution's list of submitted items. The recognition as formally submitted means that the Chamber will use the item in its holistic assessment of the entirety of the evidence for purposes of its decision pursuant to Article 74 of the Statute. Therefore, once an item is recognised as formally submitted there is no need to repeat such request (since it will already be taken into account by the Chamber).

Item 16 (no ERN)

The Prosecution objects to item 16 on the Defence's list, arguing that it has not been previously disclosed to the Prosecution, does not have an ERN and was not shown to the witness during P-0800's testimony.

The Chamber notes that the Defence has not provided this item – which it considers to be potential evidence – via the procedures laid out in the 'e-court protocol' (Annex I to the Decision Setting the Regime for Evidence Disclosure and Other Related Matters, ICC-01/09-01/20-67-AnxI). Also, it is not possible to submit an item for recognition if it has not been disclosed properly (*see*, Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings, ICC-01/09-01/20-189, para. 25 for use of material during the questioning; equally – should a party request the introduction other than through a witness – it also would have to make this item available to the other party beforehand).

Further, the Defence did not put the document to the witness during his testimony. However, the Defence in the current instance tries to submit the item in accordance with the procedure for 'items of evidence used during a hearing' (*see*, Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings, ICC-01/09-01/20-189, para. 17 (i)).

For the reasons above, the Chamber does not recognise item 16 of the Defence's list as formally submitted.

Items 29 (KEN-OTP-0106-0530), 30 (KEN-OTP-0129-0699), 31 (KEN-OTP-0145-0434), item 33 (KEN-OTP-0116-0497), and item 38 (KEN-OTP-0129-0575)

The Prosecution objects to the recognition as formally submitted for items 29-31, 33 and 38. It submits that the Defence wishes to use these items in order to impeach the witness's credibility and considers it unfair to the witness since the items have not been put to P-0800 for clarification or comments. The Prosecution cites to decisions of Trial Chamber VI in support of its view.

First, the Chamber notes that the Prosecution cites part of the Decision on the conduct of the Proceedings in another case, ICC-01/04-02/06-619 (para. 28) and requests that the Chamber applies it in the current proceedings. It then cites to another decision from the same case which cites to the exact same part of the conduct decision (ICC-01/04-02/06-1400-Red, para. 7)

The Chamber notes there is no equivalent provision in the Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings applicable in the current case. A party cannot simply rely on directions issued in another case and apply them to the current proceedings.

Nevertheless, the Chamber notes that none of these items have been put to the witness during his testimony. As explained above, a party cannot use the procedure intended for submitting items used during a hearing for items which it never used. If a party wishes to submit items that were included in its List of Materials that it did not use with the witness for whom it was intended, it must use the other available avenues to request recognition as formally submitted, i.e. use it with another witness or request introduction of evidence other than through a witness.

For these reasons, the Chamber rejects the recognition of items 29, 30, 31, 33 and 38 of the Defence's list as formally submitted.

Item 33 (KEN-OTP-0108-0234)

The Prosecution does not per se object to the recognition of the item, but points out that the item was not shown to P-0800.

As explained above, a party cannot use the procedure for items used during the hearing in order to request recognition as formally submitted, if it has not used that item during the hearing. Again, the Chamber points to the other available avenues with regard to such items.

Accordingly, the Chamber rejects the recognition as formally submitted of items 32.

With regard to the remainder of the items requested to be recognised as formally submitted the Chamber notes that the items constituting prior recorded testimony fulfil the requirements of Rule 68(3) of the Rules (as explained above). Further, the other items have been used during the testimony of P-0800. Accordingly, the Chamber recognises these items as formally submitted (to the degree that they are not already included in the Chamber's decision on the items submitted by the Prosecution)

In summary, for P-0800, the Chamber recognises all items requested by the Prosecution and all items requested by the Defence – with the exception of item 16, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 38 – as formally submitted.

The Registry is directed to proceed in accordance with paragraph 17(iv) of the Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings, 7 October 2021, ICC-01/09-01/20-189.

 Your Honour,

The Prosecution responds as follows to the Defence list of material to be submitted into evidence, sent on Friday 18 February 2021:

1. The Prosecution notes that many of the items contained on the Defence list duplicate items already listed for submission by the Prosecution. The Prosecution does not object to the submission of these items, but questions whether this is required, as it would appear to merely generate extra work for the Prosecution and the Chamber.
2. The Prosecution objects, however, to the submission of **item 16** ([REDACTED]), no ERN is provided). This item has not been registered or disclosed by the Defence, but more importantly the item was not shown to the witness. Nor does it appear to be of any relevance to his evidence, or indeed to the case. [REDACTED]
 [REDACTED] (KEN-OTP-0145-0554; KEN-OTP-0130-0087). Any relation to the present case is, at best, opaque.
3. The Prosecution also objects to the submission of the following items, which do not originate from the witness and were not shown to the witness during his testimony: **item 29**, (KEN-OTP-0106-0530), **item 30** (KEN-OTP-0129-0699), **item 31** (KEN-OTP-0145-0434), **item 33** (KEN-OTP-0116-0497), and **item 38** (KEN-OTP-0129-0575). These are investigator's reports containing summaries of communications with witnesses, including P-0800. While the Prosecution regards these as accurate summaries of the relevant communications, the Prosecution considers it unfair to the witness to submit into evidence such material for the purposes of impeachment, when the witness has not had the opportunity to review the material and provide any relevant clarifications or explanations. According to the prior jurisprudence of the Court "[T]he cross-examining party is required to put to the witness any facts *or evidence*, available at the time and upon which it intends to rely to impeach his or her credibility." (Emphasis added; *Prosecutor v. Ntaganda*, Decision on the conduct of proceedings, [ICC-01/04-02/06-619](#), 2 June 2015, para. 28; *Prosecutor v. Ntaganda*, Decision on Defence request for admission of documents used during the testimony of Witness P-0963, [ICC-01/04-02/06-1400-Red](#), 16 June 2016, para. 7.)
4. The Prosecution does not object to the introduction of **item 32** (KEN-OTP0108-0234, Report on the analysis of a mobile phone and SIM Card [REDACTED]). However, the Prosecution notes that this too was not shown to P-0800, who has thus not had the opportunity to comment on any aspects that may later be relied upon by the Defence for the purposes of impeachment. The Prosecution will thus object at the relevant time if it is relied upon by the Defence for this purpose.
