Dear Registry,

Please note that the Judges of Pre-Trial Chamber II authorise the Registry to disclose information that the Defence explicitly agrees to disclose in the Registry's confidential communication with the States identified, and instructs the Registry to liaise with the Defence for this purpose.

On behalf of the Registry I bring your kind attention to the below request for the Chamber's consideration:

The Registry would like to request the authorization of the Chamber to use information contained in Mr. Mokom's Application for Interim Release pursuant to Order ICC-01/14-01/22-105" (ICC-01/14-01/22-110-Conf) in its confidential communication with the States identified. Much of the information contained in the application would be useful for the Registry to use in its consultations so as to present a full picture of the situation to requested States, which we understand the defense does not wish to make public. The Registry further understands that the defense would not oppose this course of action.

Additionally, and in order to anticipate questions from States, the Registry would very much appreciate if the Chamber could kindly confirm whether these consultations to be carried out by the Registry are in advance of formal consultations to be undertaken by the Chamber at a later stage pursuant to Regulation 51 of the Regulations of the Court.
