The Single Judge takes note of the *‘Defence’s Observations on Registry’s Observations on the Prosecution’s “Request for leave to add one item to the List of Evidence (ICC-01/14-01/18-1702-Conf)” (ICC-01/14-01/18-1794-Conf)’*, ICC-01/14-01/18-1807-Conf; the *‘Yekatom Defence Observations further to the “Registry’s Observations on the Prosecution’s “Request for leave to add one item to the List of Evidence (ICC-01/14-01/18-1702-Conf)”’*, ICC-01/14-01/18-1794-Conf, 13 March 2023, ICC-01/14-01/18-1809-Conf and Red (jointly, the ‘Defence Observations’); as well as the *‘Prosecution’s Consolidated Response to “Defence Observations on Registry’s Observations on the Prosecution’s “Request for leave to add one item to the List of Evidence (ICC-01/14-01/18-1702-Conf)” (ICC-01/14-01/18-1794-Conf)’*, ICC-01/14-01/18-1807-Conf, 21 March 2023 and *“Yekatom Defence Observations, ICC-01/14-01/18-1809-Conf”, ICC-01/14-01/18-1816-Conf*.
