The Chamber notes the submission of items by the parties (Email from the Prosecution dated 21 September 2021 at 17:42 and corresponding attachment; Email from the Defence dated 21 September 2021 at 17:15) following the testimony of P-0654.

The Chamber takes note of the parties' response to the submission of items by the other party (Email from the Prosecution dated 22 September 2021 at 12:46 and email from the Defence dated 24 September 2021 at 16:53) as well as their replies (Email from the Prosecution dated 27 September 2021 at 17:55; Email from the Defence dated 23 September 2021 at 09:35).

The items which the Prosecution seeks to submit [REDACTED] includes one item which was only used during the Defence's cross examination of P-0654 (MLI-OTP-0068-4637).

Particularly noting that the Defence does not object to its submission, the Chamber authorises the submission of this item.

The Chamber notes that the Defence makes several objections which it categorises in the following five groups:

- (i) Category B Objections: items regarding which the witness does not have any personal knowledge of the circumstances of the creation of these documents or any familiarity with their contents;
- (ii) Category C Objections: documents lacking integrity and reliability;
- (iii) Category D Objections: items that raise issues of chain of custody issue;
- (iv) Category E Objections: transcripts and translations which are derivative material of audio / video material objected to; and
- (v) Category F Objections: [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] – as the Prosecution indicated that it withdraws the submission of the item subject to this category of objection, the Chamber will not consider the parties' submissions on this objection any further.

In line with its previous rulings, the Chamber considers that the aforementioned arguments do not prevent the submission of these items at this stage but will rather be considered as part of the holistic assessment of all evidence submitted when deciding on the guilt or innocence of the accused, having due regard to the submissions made by the parties.

Considering that all items the parties seek to submit were sufficiently used or discussed with P-0654, the Chamber authorises their submission, with the exception of MLI-OTP-0012-1584. The Registry is directed to proceed in accordance with paragraph 34(vi) of the Directions on the conduct of the proceedings (ICC-01/12-01/18-789-AnxA).

A brief response in relation to each challenged item, including references to relevant passages of transcripts, is included in the right column in the Defence's table below, within the Defence's original email.

Category B Objections: The witness does not have any personal knowledge of the circumstances of the creation of these documents or any familiarity with their contents.

Each of the challenged items under Category B was shown to P-0654, who was able to meaningfully comment on them.

With respect to open source videos (item no. 2, 3 and 4 in the Defence table), [REDACTED]
 [REDACTED] does not preclude their submission through this witness. The items of footage were in fact used and discussed with P-0654 who identified relevant members of the armed groups, a location, an event or items such as their flag, depicted therein.

For all these reasons, the Prosecution submits that the Defence objections should be dismissed and the items submitted and ultimately admitted as evidence.

Dear Counsel,

Pursuant to paragraph 34(iii) of ICC-01/12-01/18-789-AnxA, the Defence provides its objections to the Prosecution's List of Material for Submission regarding P-0654.

The Defence has identified several categories of objection which relate to the various documents. The objection codes and short submissions concerning the basis of these objections are listed below. All transcript references are to the confidential English edited or corrected version.

For each of the objections contained below, even if the Chamber decides that the threshold to reject submission of the items is not met, the arguments underpinning these objections relate to the probative value and weight that can safely be placed on these items (as *per* the Trial Chamber's email decision of 2 June 2021).

Category B Objections: The witness does not have any personal knowledge of the circumstances of the creation of these documents or any familiarity with their contents.

The Defence refers to its previous submissions concerning the weight that can be attributed to items that are not self-authenticating/open source, in circumstances where the prosecution has not adduced evidence concerning the circumstances of the creation of these documents or the reliability of the contents.

Having failed to elicit evidence concerning P-0654's personal knowledge of these documents, submission of these documents through P-0654 would be prejudicial and unfair.

The witness's evidence raises concerns as to its accuracy as concerns the evidential items involved and can therefore not form a foundation for their submission.

Chambers have considered in the past that ‘while photocopies of documents may be admissible evidence before the Tribunal, a sufficient foundation must be laid for their admission so as to satisfy the Chamber that they are at least prima facie reliable’ ([Muvunyi](#), para. 15).

Dear Colleagues,

Pursuant to paragraph 34(iv) of ICC-01/12-01/18-789-AnxA, the Defence provides its response to the Prosecution's submissions in relation to the Defence's List of Material for Submission for Witness P-0654. The Defence renews its request for the submission of these items through this witness.

In relation to the Prosecution's comments regarding Defence Tab 81 (MLI-OTP-0029-0085) and Defence Tab 82 (MLI-D28-0005-7249) that 'the witness was not provided with the full context of the "denials", as he was not shown the passages from the same article where Sanda Ould Bamama further denied that women were arrested or put in jail' and '[t]his was not fair to the witness, as he did not have an opportunity to understand the full nature of the alleged denials made by Sanda Ould Bamama, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] the Prosecution is simply in error.

In the article, Sanda states that no women were being detained by the groups but that there were plans to open a special prison for women next to the general prison for men (MLI-D28-0005-7249 at 7249). Counsel for the Defence specifically questioned the witness about this allegation, repeatedly asking the witness on three occasions if he was aware of a special prison for women which was located next to the general prison (T-134, p. 87, lines 13-14; p. 87, line 23 to p. 88, line 1; and p. 88, lines 12-15). In response to all of these questions, the witness demonstrated no awareness of a women's prison located next to the main prison and responded to say that he had heard about women being detained in the ATM room of the BMS, but that he had never seen it himself (T-134, p. 87, line 13 to p. 88, line 21). As such, the allegation made by Sanda in this article concerning the detention of women was fully explored with the witness in an open way, and the witness had no knowledge of a women's prison next to the main prison. The Defence notes in this regard that this women's prison next to the main prison is also referred to [REDACTED] (T-041, pp. 59-61, stating in particular at T-041, p. 59, line 23 to p. 60, line 2: [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] and T-041, p. 61, lines 4-7: [REDACTED]

Specifically regarding [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The witness's testimony on this point, including both examination-in-chief and cross-examination, [REDACTED] were sitting on a bench 'for the entire duration' (T-129, p. 38, lines 8-14) and that when he went to as [REDACTED] le' (T-134, p. 85, lines 6-8). Furthermore, the witness testified that [REDACTED] (T-129, p. 33, lines 12-18).

Furthermore, concerning the issue of the dress code, the subject about which the witness was questioned in relation to these items, the Prosecution's objection appears to be predicated on the assumption that the Chamber cannot rely on what is said by Sanda Aboumama in this interview concerning the dress code in light of the other material in this

interview. Sanda's comments in this interview regarding the dress code are almost identical to the position set out by [REDACTED] (T-134, p. 57, line 19 to p. 60, line 12). The Prosecution, as an impartial minister of justice, cannot advance inconsistent positions of fact in the same case.

In relation to Defence Tab 140-MLI-OTP-0004-3189/Tab 143 – MLI-D28-0004-3227/Tab 144 – MLI-D28-0004-3228, the Defence agrees that the reference is to the *comité de mœurs* or *assemblée de mœurs*. The reference to a brigade was in error.

In relation to Defence Tab 209 – MLI-D28-0005-7194, the Defence agrees that the reference should be the laws and attitudes after 2012.

In relation to Defence Tab 215 – MLI-D28-0005-7218, there is no basis for the Prosecution's serious allegation that the Defence's submissions are that [REDACTED] and that therefore the Defence is putting forward a proposition it knows to be incorrect. The description of this being of an individual the witness said had a resemblance to [REDACTED] is relevant to, as the Defence stated in its original submissions, the witness's knowledge of, and attitude towards, the groups.

The Prosecution has no objection to the submission of the items listed below as they have been broadly used with Prosecution Witness P-0654.

However, the Prosecution does object to the ultimate admission through Prosecution witness P-0654, and/or wishes to highlight the mischaracterisation of P-0654's evidence, in relation to the following items of evidence:

Defence Tab 59: MLI-OTP-0012-1941: The Prosecution does not object to admission of this video. However, the Prosecution observes that the Defence has mischaracterised [REDACTED]'s evidence. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] See T-135, p.58, l.5 – p.59, l.2.

Defence Tab 81: MLI-OTP-0029-0085/Defence Tab 82: MLI-D28-0005-7249: The Prosecution does not object to admission of these documents. However, the Prosecution observes that when the Chamber assesses the witness's response to questions in relation to this document it should be mindful of the exchange following the Prosecution's objection that the witness was not provided with the full context of the "denials", as he was not shown the passages from the same article where Sanda Ould Bamama further

denied that women were arrested or put in jail. In spite of Defence Counsel indicating that she would return to the document so the witness would then have an opportunity to see the whole article, she never did so. See T-134, p.55, l.10-p.57, l.13. This was not fair to the witness, as he did not have an opportunity to understand the full nature of the alleged denials made by Sanda Ould Bamama, [REDACTED]

Defence Tab 140-MLI-OTP-0004-3189/Tab 143 – MLI-D28-0004-3227/Tab 144 – MLI-D28-0004-3228: The Prosecution objects to admission of these documents through this witness. He is not the appropriate witness through whom these items should be admitted as evidence. [REDACTED], whose facebook posts these are stated to come from, will be coming to testify. In particular, P-0654 was not asked to confirm whether he had previously seen the posts or if he could confirm the accuracy of the content of these items. The Prosecution further observes that the three documents refer to “*l’assemblée des mœurs*”, “*une assemblée pour la correction des mœurs*” or “*comité des mœurs*” - and not the “*Brigade des Mœurs*” (or Hesbah established by the armed groups in 2012-2013) that the Defence wrongly states below, are mentioned. These are not the same institutions. P-0654 also referred to the group in question as “*comité des mœurs*”. See e.g. T-0133-Conf-FRA-ET, p.11, l.27; p.14, l.2; p.20, l.8.

Defence Tab 158 – MLI-OTP-0005-2471: The Prosecution objects to admission of this document through P-0654, and objects to admission for the truth of its contents. In particular, although the witness indicated he had personal knowledge of a demonstration, which the article mentions, he confirmed that the demonstration “was not against the sale of alcohol as such” but because prohibited things were happening including lots of noise – and said he was not aware of a demonstration involving only women. See T-132, p.85, l.24 – p.86, l.14.

Defence Tab 171 – MLI-D28-0005-7037: The Prosecution does not object to admission of this document. However, the Prosecution observes that P-0654 clarified that [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] See T-134, p.4, l.25 – p.6, l.5.

Defence Tab 194 – MLI-D28-0005-7120/Tab 195 – MLI-D28-0005-7138: The Prosecution objects to admission of these items through P-0654. The witness confirmed that [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] See T-135, p.18, l.15 – p.19, l.20.

Defence Tab 209 – MLI-D28-0005-7194: The Prosecution objects to the admission of this document, and observes that it is dated 2017 so disputes the relevance of the item. In particular the Prosecution submits that contrary to what the Defence asserts it is not relevant to the laws and attitudes prior to 2012.

Defence Tab 215 – MLI-D28-0005-7218: The Prosecution does not object to the admission of this document. However, the Prosecution refers to the witness’s clear testimony that [REDACTED]

Defence Tab 219 – MLI-D28-0005-7220/Tab 220- MLI-D28-0005-7222/Defence Tab 221-MLI-D28-0005-7226: The Prosecution objects to admission of these documents through P-0654, and objects to admission of

such items for the truth of their content. The Prosecution repeatedly objected to questions put to the witness regarding these items, when he was never asked any questions as to whether he had ever seen them, or could comment in any manner in relation to their provenance or authenticity. In spite of those objections being upheld, Defence persisted in failing to establish any foundation for admission of such items through P-0654. See e.g. T-133, p.26, l.21 – p.28, l.13. Accordingly, no foundation was established for admission of these items through P-0654, and these items are insufficiently reliable to be admitted for the truth of their content.
