 Dear all,

Pursuant to regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court, the Defence for Mr Yekatom respectfully requests the Chamber to grant an extension of time to respond to "Common Legal Representatives' Joint Request for the Formal Submission of P-0925's Additional Expert Report and Associated Material pursuant to Rule 68(3) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (ICC-01/14-01/18-1848-Conf)".

The Defence requests this extension in light of the recent disclosure of the Report which is the object of the Request (courtesy copy received on 17 April 2023) and its associated material (formally disclosed on 24 April 2023). Indeed, the analysis of these new documents amounting to 348 pages is necessary to allow the Defence to provide meaningful submissions on the Request.

Bearing in mind the Chamber's previous directions on *inter partes* consultations, the Defence consulted with the Common Legal Representatives of Victims on Friday and the latter indicated that they did not object to the Defence request for extension of time.

For the above-mentioned reasons, the Defence considers that there is good cause to grant an extension of time and kindly request the Chamber to set the new deadline to 12 May 2023.
