Dear Prosecution,

The Chamber has considered the Updated Schedule of Witness Appearance below and has observed that for P-1967 you indicate that approximately 4 hours will be needed for the parties to examine him. Yet, you have scheduled three hearing days with two sessions each, amounting to nine hours in total.

The Chamber further notes that the Schedule does not foresee anything for 26 July, the final day of the block.

While the Chamber understands the wish to allow sufficient flexibility in the schedule to absorb unforeseen circumstances, it is of the view that this cannot result in substantial amounts of courtroom time being lost. Indeed, the Chamber has already been sitting reduced hours for an extended period of time and a lot of courtroom time has been lost due to unforeseen problems and poor planning.

Accordingly, it hereby instructs the parties to finalise the examination of P-1967 by 12 July 2024. The remainder of the witnesses will all start one day sooner. This leaves 25 and 26 July available for the testimony of P-0834, which is scheduled to take around 4 hours.

Finally, the Chamber reminds the Prosecution, as stressed by the Presiding Judge in today's hearing, of its standing instruction to have at least one witness on 'standby' who could be called to testify if another witness becomes unavailable. The Chamber observes, in this regard, that it is not excluded that the Chamber may be sitting for full days for part of the next block, depending on the advice of the medical expert and the parties' submissions in this regard.

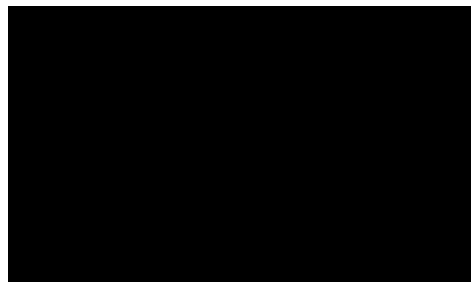
