Dear Isabelle,

The Chamber has taken note of the fact that P-0349 is expected to testify via video link [REDACTED].

The Chamber also notes that the VWU is reasonably confident that the facilities in the remote location will offer the same or equivalent conditions as the ICC Field Office in Bangui. It further notes that the same facility was already successfully used in another case.

Based on this, the Chamber is satisfied that the venue chosen for the conduct of the AVL is conducive to the giving of truthful and open testimony and to the safety and wellbeing of the witnesses concerned. Accordingly, the Chamber finds that the conditions of rule 67 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence will be satisfied and authorises the remote testimony of P-0349.

The Chamber expects the Registry to ensure that the witness will be able to testify from a secure, quiet and private room, which will be access-controlled by the Registry. In addition, the Chamber expects the Registry to ensure that the witness will not be influenced during his testimony, including during breaks, and that the witness will be able to see the interlocutors in the courtroom during questioning. Lastly, the Chamber expects that any recommendations regarding special measures can be implemented from the remote location.
