Dear Colleagues,

Please kindly be informed that, in accordance with its assessment of vulnerable witnesses, the psychologist of the Victims and Witnesses Unit has conducted a vulnerability assessment of witness **DAR-D31-P-0035**.

After the assessment, the VWU psychologist recommends the following special measures according to Rule 88 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence:

1. Measures to adapt the sitting hours to the needs and capacities of the witness

- 1.1. *Sitting hours should start only in the afternoon.*
- 1.2. *15 minutes break every hour and not up to 3 hours of overall testimony.*
- 1.3. *Observe the witness closely; in case of signs of fatigue or discomfort a break is allowed or witness is asked if he needs a break.*

The VWU remains at the disposal of the Chamber.
