Dear Trial Chamber V,

Pursuant to the Chamber's "Tenth Decision on Mr Ngaissona's Restrictions on Contacts and Communications in Detention," issued on 29 December 2024 ("Decision," ICC-01/14-01/18-2741-Conf), wherein the Registry was directed to file a public redacted version of its Eleventh Report (ICC-01/14-01/18-2724-Conf) within one week of the Decision, the Registry respectfully informs the Chamber that no redactions are required for the Report. Accordingly, the Registry seeks the Chamber's authorisation to reclassify its Eleventh Report as public.

Furthermore, with regard to the Registry's "Tenth Report on Mr Ngaissona's Restrictions on Contacts and Communications in Detention," filed on 12 April 2024 (ICC-01/14-01/18-2444-Conf), the Registry notes that it submitted a request for reclassification to public via email on 6 May 2024 (see attached).
