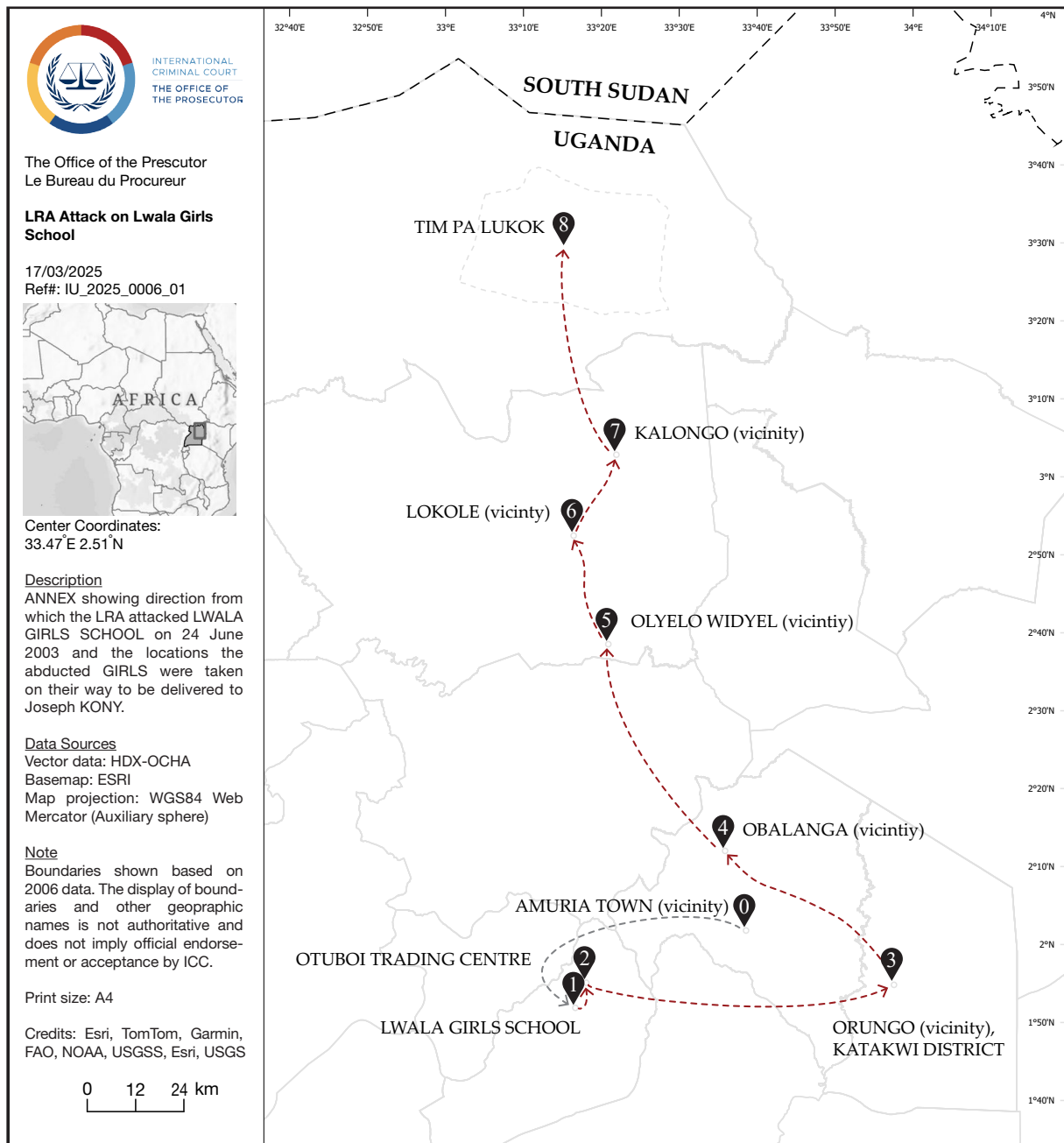

- (0) – prior to the attack, commanders Charles KAPERRE and LAGULU were in the vicinity of **AMURIA, Amuria district**. TABULEY orders them to identify school to attack to abduct schoolgirls.
- (1) – on/about 24 June 2003, LRA fighters under KAPERRE and LAGULU's command attacked **LWALA GIRLS SCHOOL**.
- (2) – on/about 24 June 2003, LRA fighters took at least 70 girls from the school to Otuboi trading centre in **OTUBOI, Kaberamaido district** where LRA looted food and other items from shops.
- (3) – on/about 24 June 2003, LRA fighters and abducted girls walk to **ORUNGO, Katakwi district**. On 25 June 2003, at least 12 girls were released by KAPERRE, and he reports to TABULEY on radio about the attack and abducted girls. On 26 June 2003, the remaining girls are divided into 6 groups in TABULEY's brigade. TABULEY commends KAPERRE and instructs for remaining girls to be taken to OTTI.
- (4) – on 28 June 2003, OTTI reports his location as being in the area of **OBALANGA**.
- (5) – on/about 30 June 2003, remaining girls are taken to OTTI in **OLYEL WIDYEL, Pader district** (present-day Agago district) by KAPERRE & TABULEY.
- (6) – on/about 1 July 2003, the remaining girls were taken to **LOKOLE, Pader district** and (7) then taken towards **KALONGO**.
- (8) – on/about 7 July 2003, four girls were taken by TABULEY, KAPERRE and OTTI to **TIM PA LUKOK** where KONY was, and where he selected two girls for himself.
