Dear Chamber,

After review of the Registry's transmissions of victim applications in *the Prosecutor v. Alfred Yekatom and Patrice- Edouard Ngaissona* case, we would like to bring to your attention that the Registry found two typographical mistakes in Annex 1 of the Sixteenth Registry Assessment report on Victim Applications for Participation in Trial Proceedings ("Annex 1"), ICC-01/14-01/18-1259. Specifically, in Annex 1 application a/20277/21 was **erroneously listed as a/20077/21 instead of a/20277/21**; and application a/20275/21 was **erroneously listed as a/20075/21 instead of a/20275/21**.

However, these typographical mistakes do not affect the substance of the legal assessment for all applications involved, which have been correctly transmitted only once to the Chamber as follows:

- **a/20077/21** was transmitted on 30 April 2021, as annex 1 to the Sixth Registry Transmission of **Group A** Applications for Victims' Participation in Trial Proceedings, ICC-01/14-01/18-974 (admitted through Decision ICC-01/14-01/18-1009 and erroneously rejected through ICC-01/14-01/18-1274),
- **a/20277/21** was transmitted on 25 January 2022 as annex 21 to the Ninth Registry Transmission of **Group B** Applications for Victim Participation in Trial Proceedings, ICC-01/14-01/18-1261 (no decision issued yet),

- **a/20075/21** was transmitted on 27 July 2022, as annex 1 to the Tenth Registry Transmission of **Group B** Applications for Victim Participation in Trial Proceedings, ICC-01/14-01/18-1528, and (rejected through Decision ICC-01/14-01/18-1672 and erroneously through ICC-01/14-01/18-1274)
- **a/20275/21** was transmitted on 25 January 2022, as annex 20 to the Ninth Registry Transmission of **Group B** Applications for Victim Participation in Trial Proceedings, ICC-01/14-01/18-1261 (no decision was issued yet).

The typographical mistakes in Annex 1 have led to identical typographical mistakes in the Fourteenth Decision on Victims' Participation in Trial Proceedings (Groups A and B) issued on 9 February 2022 (ICC-01/14-01/18-1274-AnxB, page 4). In this decision, application a/20077/21 was erroneously rejected instead of a/20277/21; and application a/20075/21 was erroneously rejected instead of a/20275/21.

The Registry sincerely apologizes for these errors and remains at the Chamber's disposal for any way forward the Chamber may deem appropriate in this matter. In light of the above, the Registry respectfully proposes to file a corrigendum of Annex 1.
