[REDACTED] Accordingly, the Single Judge rules on the contested redactions as set out in the table below.

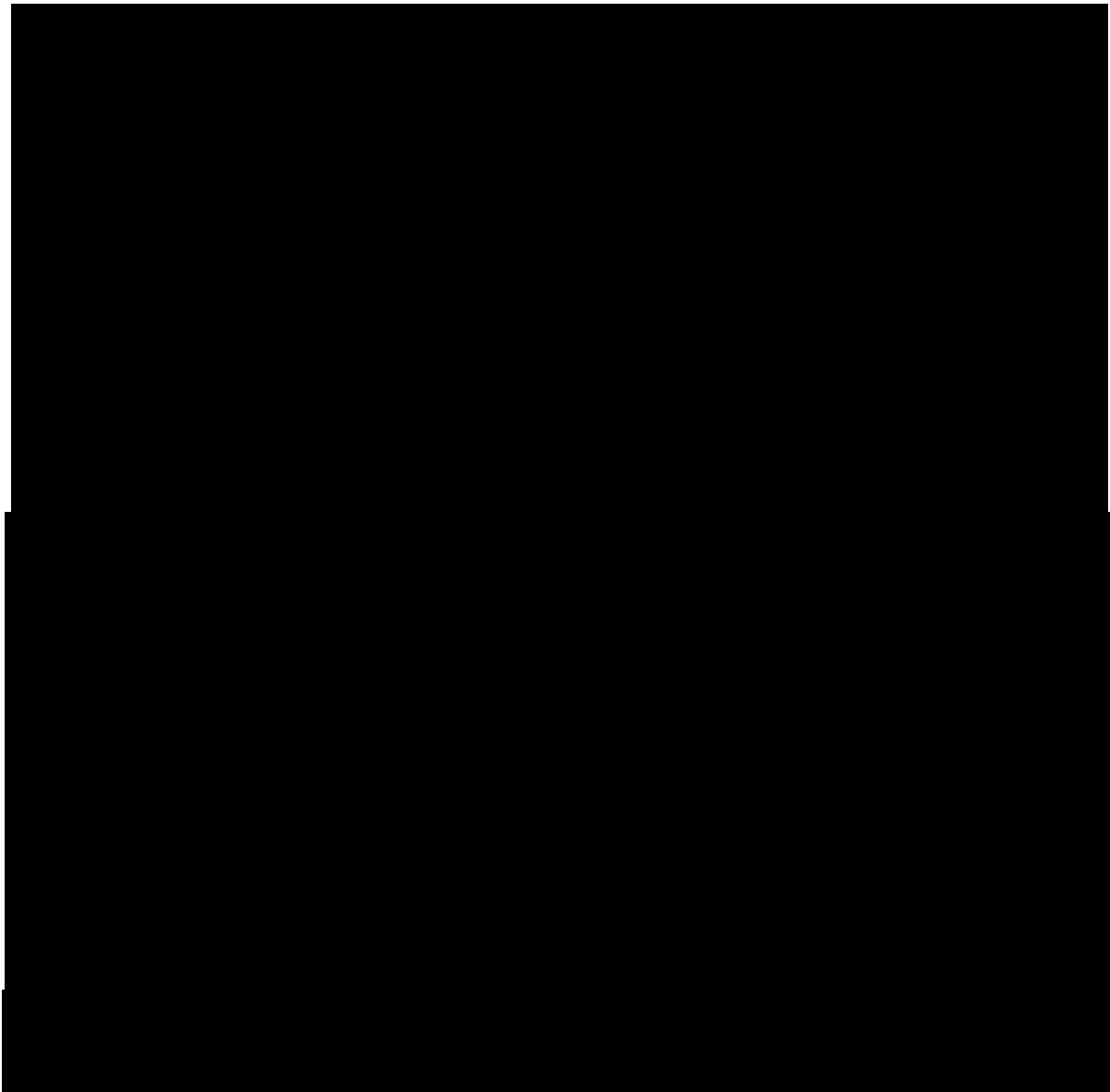
In line with paragraph 72 of the Initial Directions, ICC-01/14-01/18-631, the Single Judge does not address the uncontested redactions.
