Dear Colleagues in Pre-Trial Chamber I,

The Registry would like to respectfully inform the Chamber that it does not agree with the reclassification to public of filings ICC-01/21-01/25-175-Conf and ICC-01/21-01/25-188-Conf, as they refer to the Chamber's "Order inviting observations pursuant to rule 119(3) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 51 of the Regulations of the Court" (ICC-01/21-01/25-155-Conf) which is currently registered as confidential, and as they refer to information related to communications from State authorities containing sensitive information and information that has been consistently redacted from the public redacted documents submitted by both the Office of the Prosecutor and the Defence Counsel.

In addition, Annexes II and IV of ICC-01/21-01/25-175-Conf and Annex II of ICC-01/21-01/25-188-Conf should remain confidential as they refer to communications from the State authorities.

The Registry will therefore propose redacted versions. In accordance with Regulation 31(2) of the ROC, the Registry would like to ask for an extension of the deadline to submit a proposed public redacted version, which will be based on the Public Redacted version of the Chamber's order. The Registry needs additional time to consult with the State authorities to request their observations in relation to the level of classification of the information that was transmitted to the Court.

Dear colleagues,

With regard to the interim release matter, the Chamber notes that several filings were submitted as either ‘confidential’ or ‘confidential ex parte’. - (3) the Prosecution to file a public redacted version of ICC-01/21-01/25-252-Conf-Exp, or indicate by email that it agrees with it being reclassified as public.
