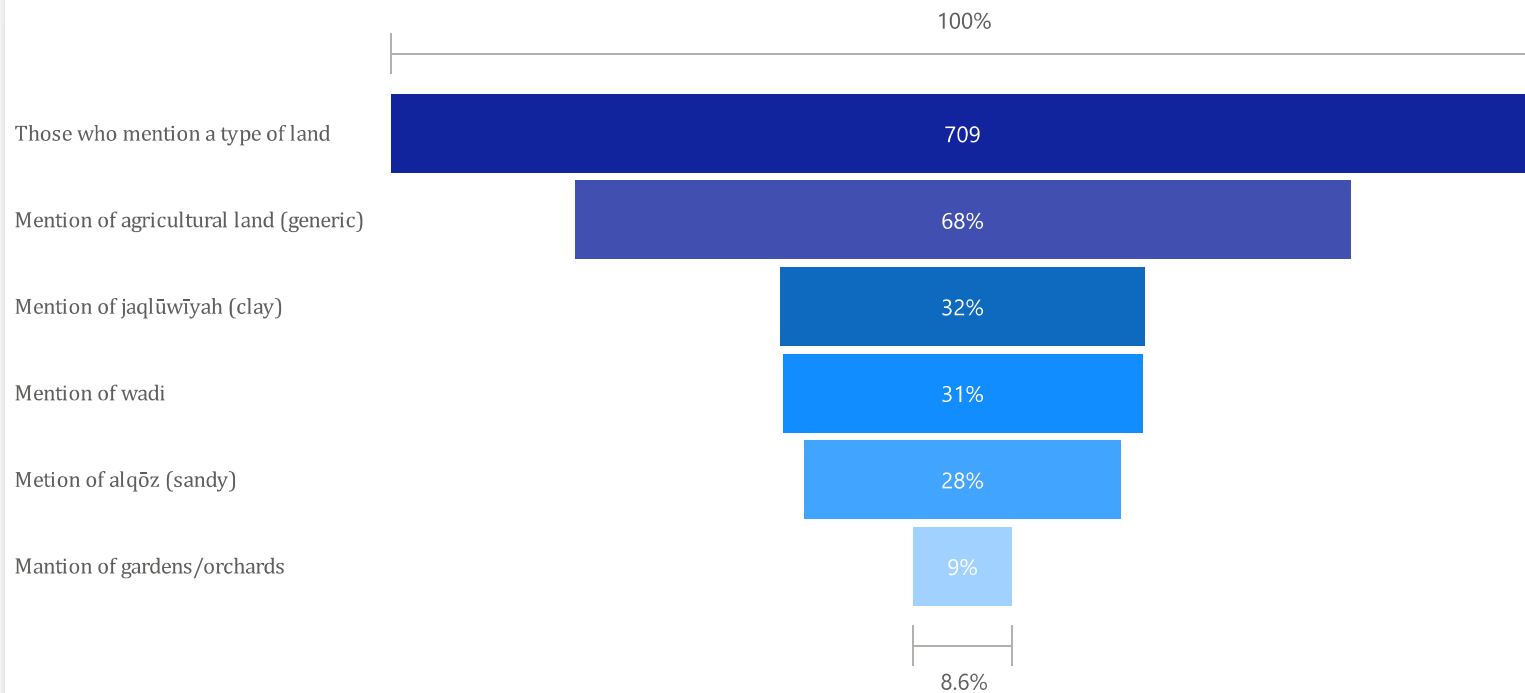

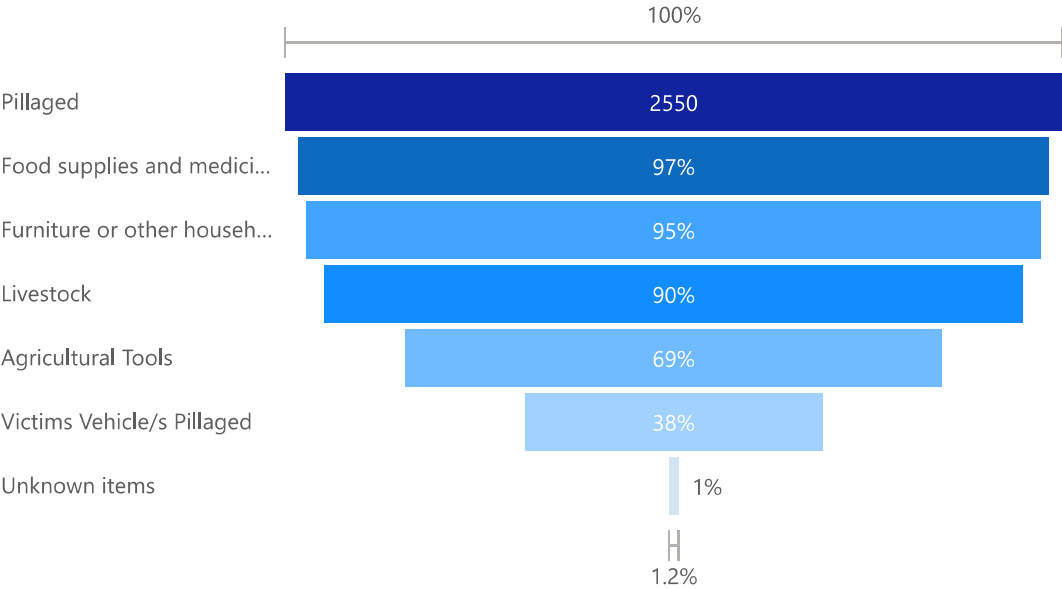


Area of Bindisi in which the direct victim resided

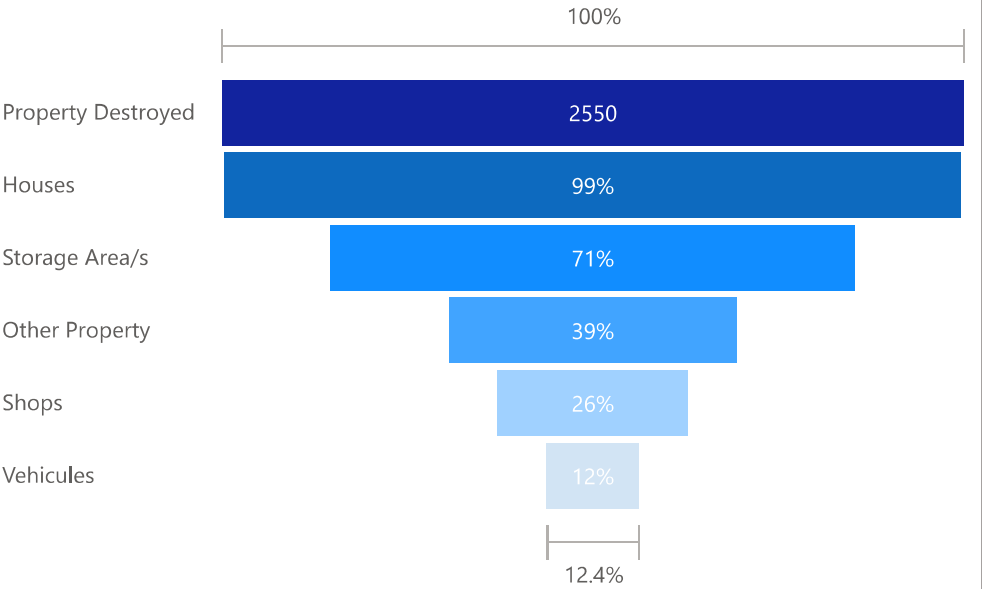
