Dear counsel,

In case the Prosecution considers that redactions are necessary to protect the identity of witnesses or possible co-suspects, and notwithstanding the requirement to provide an unredacted version at a later stage of the proceedings, the Prosecution is instructed to file a confidential redacted version of its application for the warrant of arrest (ICC-01/11-172-US-Exp) and its annexes, in order to have the document ready for when Mr El Hishri will arrive at the Court's Detention Centre or when the application is requested as part of the Article 59 proceedings in Germany. This confidential-redacted version must be filed by no later than Monday, 28 July 2025. In case the Prosecution considers that no redactions are necessary for the version that is to be provided to Mr El Hishri and his defence, it shall inform the Chamber by that same date.

In order to issue a public-redacted version in advance of the first appearance of Mr El Hishri, once he is surrendered by Germany to the Court, the Prosecution is instructed to file public redacted versions of its application for the warrant of arrest (ICC-01/11-172-US-Exp) and its annexes, or reclassify them as public if no redactions are necessary, by no later than Wednesday, 30 July 2025.

Please note that in case a request is received in relation to the Article 59 proceedings or Mr El Hishri is surrendered to the Court earlier than the two aforementioned dates, the Prosecution must ensure that the confidential-redacted version is ready to be provided to Mr El Hishri upon arrival in the Detention Centre and the public-redacted version one day after his arrival to the Detention Centre.
