Dear colleagues, Dear Counsel,

To inform its management of the case as well as adjudication of ongoing and upcoming requests, the Chamber considers that it should be in receipt of updated information regarding the current security situation in Libya. In order to do this, it instructs the Registry to prepare reports on the political context and any governance issues, the evolving profile of the Court in Libya, as well as any other relevant information regarding the security situation in the area of concern, including on patterns, trends or developments that could affect victims and witnesses (and/or their relatives). The first such report is to be put on the record of the case by 22 January 2026 and to be followed by a second report, bringing to the Chamber's attention any relevant updates, by 5 May 2026. A version of these reports, redacted if necessary, must be made available to the parties.
