

ANNEX III

List of Victims Assessed as Eligible by VPRS and transmitted to the TFV

This annex provides a summary of the lists of information of all victims assessed as eligible by VPRS, regardless of their notification status.

In the previous report, the TFV indicated that it had received the eligibility assessments of 2,356 victims. During the present reporting period, the TFV received an additional six batches of assessments with 2,439 victims. In total, the 12 batches transmitted to the TFV comprise 4,795 victims assessed as eligible.

The transmissions received by the TFV during the reporting period are summarized below:

The transmission also covers the information of 35 victims who were not participating victims, including 2 falling in the first priority category, 29 in the third category and 4 in the fourth category. 31 of these individuals completed household applications and were thus compiled in a separate sheet in the cumulative table, as in the previous transmission.
Eighth batch of information	17 December 2025	669	The transmission covers the information of 580 participating victims, including 3 assessed as falling in the first priority category, 575 in the second category, and 2 in the fourth category. 89 victims who were not participating victims including 9 assessed as falling in the first category, 71 in the third category and 9 in the fourth. 68 of these individuals completed household applications

			and were thus compiled in a separate sheet in the cumulative table.
Ninth batch of information	21 January 2026	842	Information of 729 participating victims, 14 assessed as falling in the first priority category, 714 in the second category, and 1 in the fourth category. 113 victims who were not participating victims and completed group applications (including 11 assessed as falling in the first priority category, 81 in the third category, and 21 in the fourth category).
Tenth batch of information	25 February 2026	449	The transmission covers the information of 417 participating victims, including 4 assessed as falling in the first priority category, 279 in the second category, 31 in the third category and 103 in the fourth category. 32 victims who were not participating victims, including 14 assessed as falling in the third category and 18 in the fourth category. 24 of these individuals completed household applications and were thus compiled in a separate sheet in the cumulative table.
Eleventh batch of information	18 March 2026	136	The transmission covers the information of 3 participating victims, including 2 assessed as falling in the second priority category and 1 in the fourth category. 133 victims who were not participating victims, including 6 assessed as falling in the first priority category, 103 in the third category and 24 in the fourth category. 111 of these individuals completed household applications and were thus compiled in a separate sheet in the cumulative table.
Twelfth batch of information	22 April 2026	224	The transmission covers the information of 24 assessed as falling in the first priority category, 153 in the third category, and 47 in the fourth category. 9 participating victims whose information was transmitted previously and were therefore not included in the present batch of 224 victims, were identified as deceased and had completed

			resumption of action (RoA) forms from the families.
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
