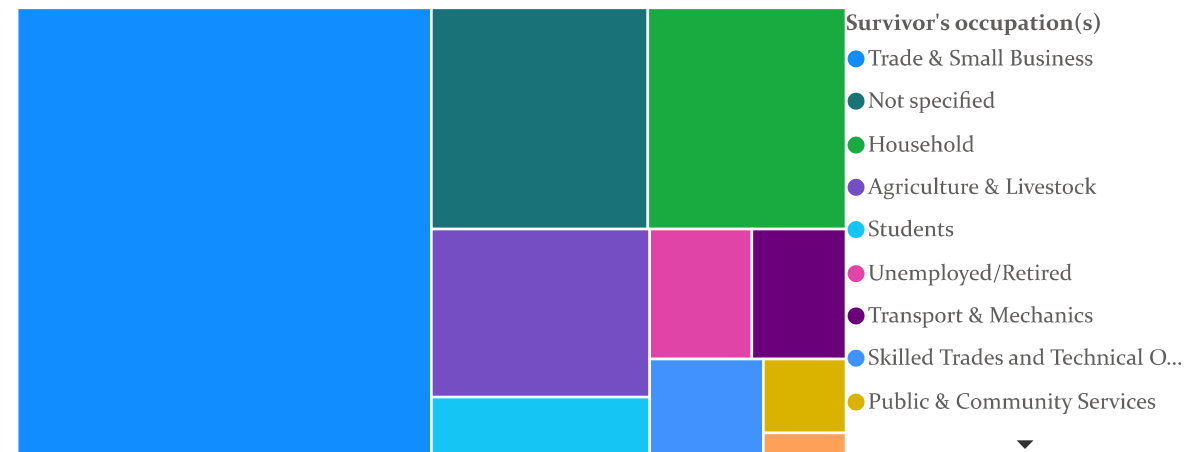
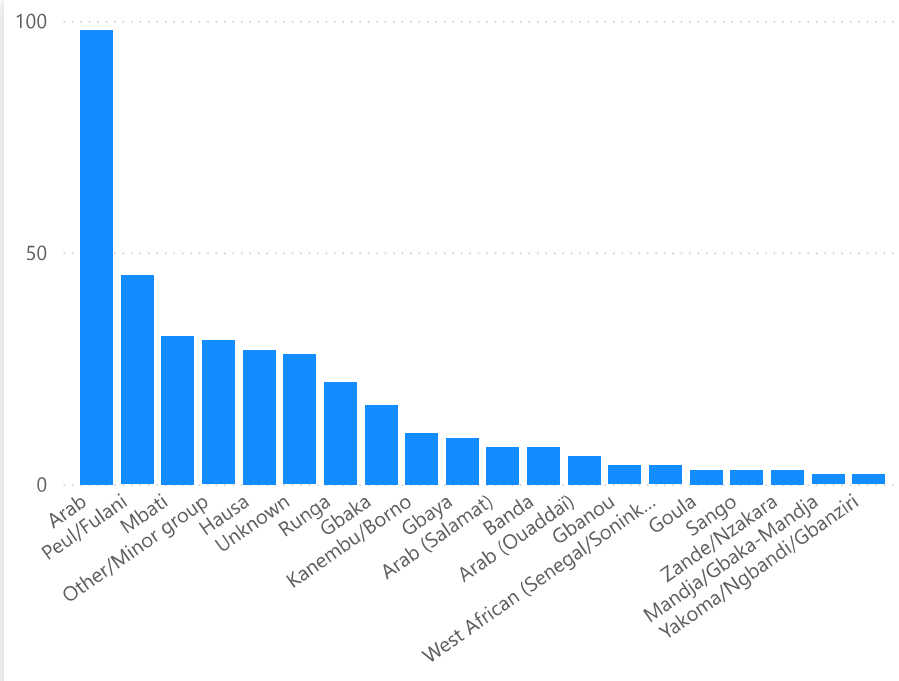
Overview of areas adjacent to Cattin and Boeing

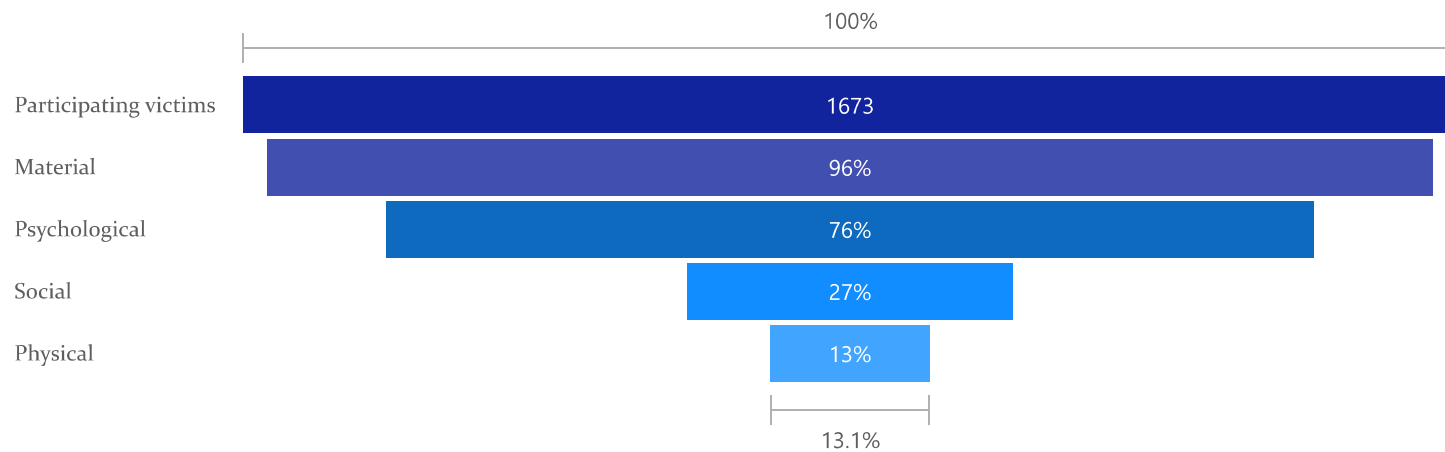

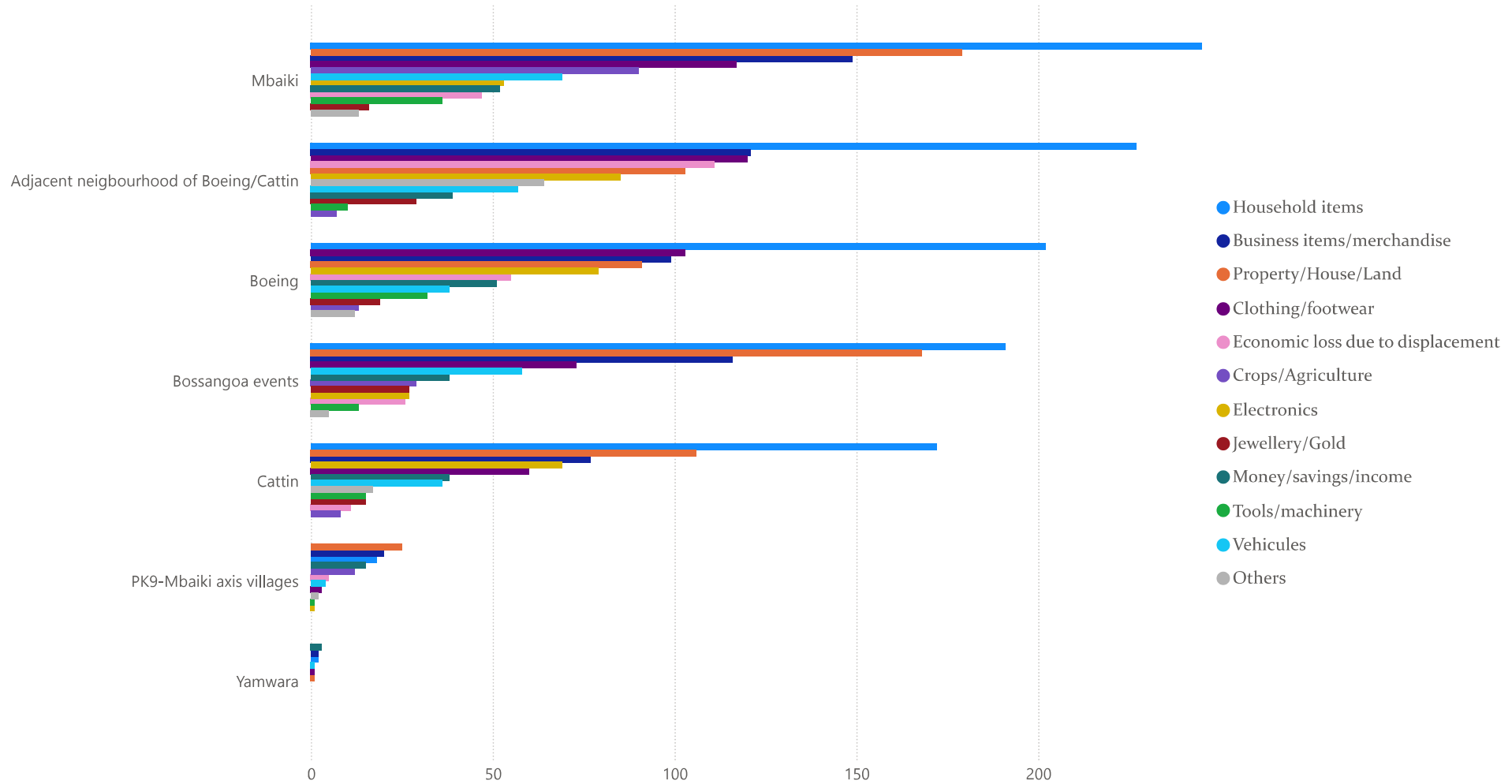
Types of crime reported



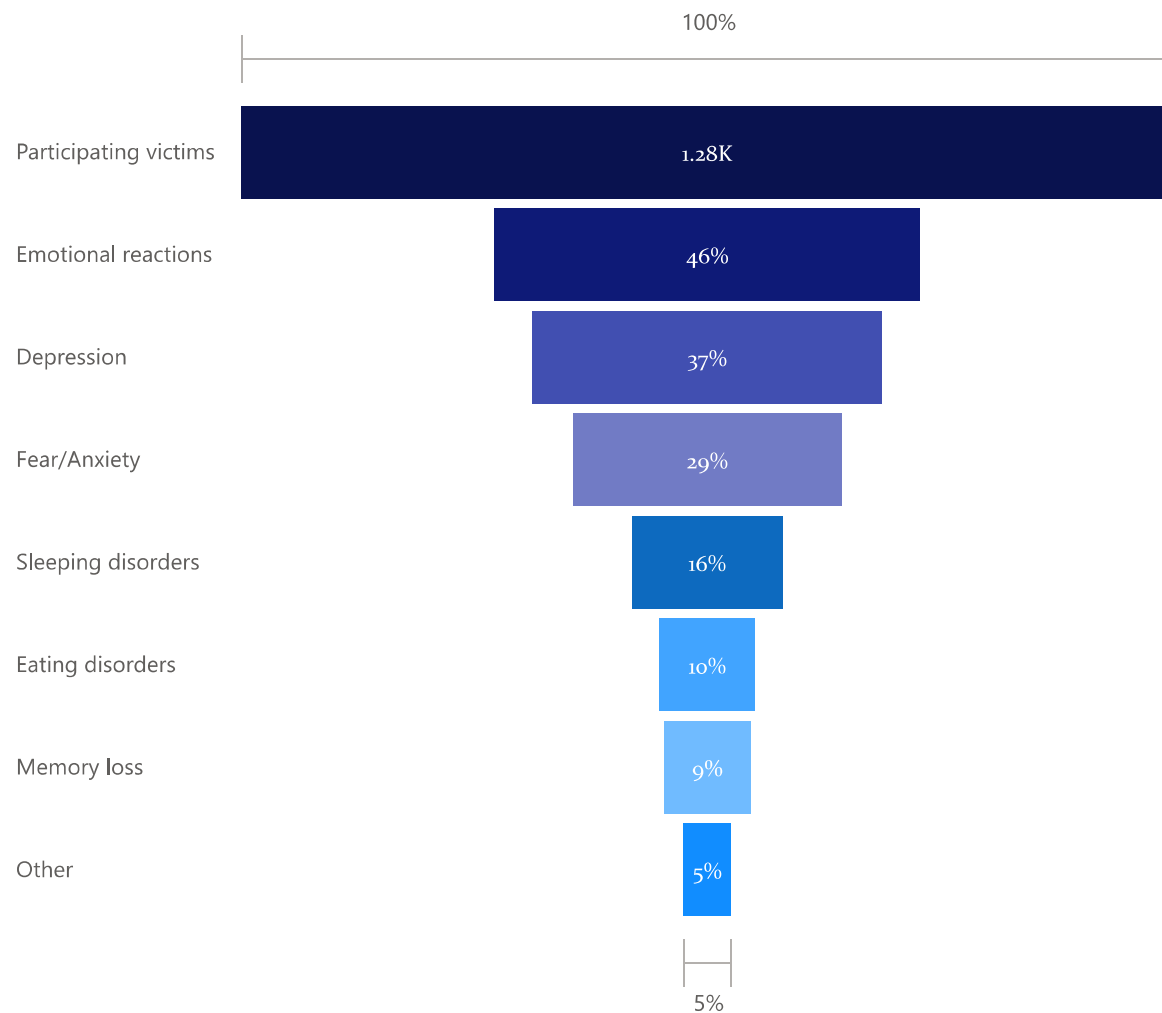
Overview type of harms - all events

Psychological harm - all events

"Emotional reactions" include symptoms such as distress, anger, irritability, emotional shock, worrying or pensiveness.

"Depression" includes symptoms such as sadness, hopelessness, low self-esteem, isolation, suicidal thoughts.

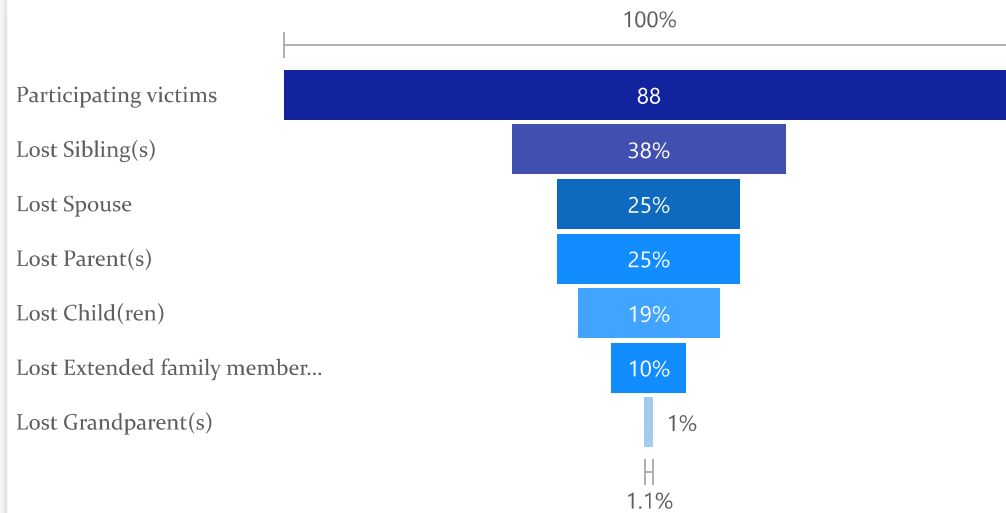
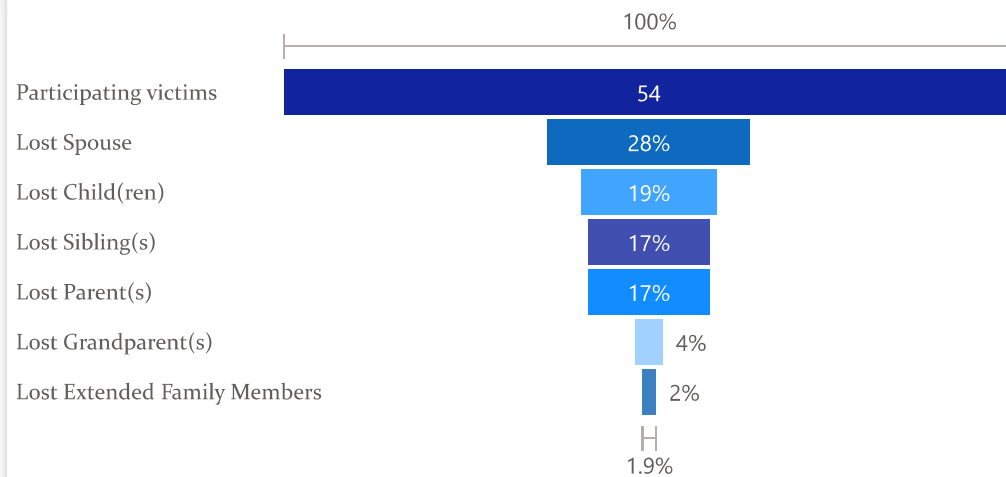
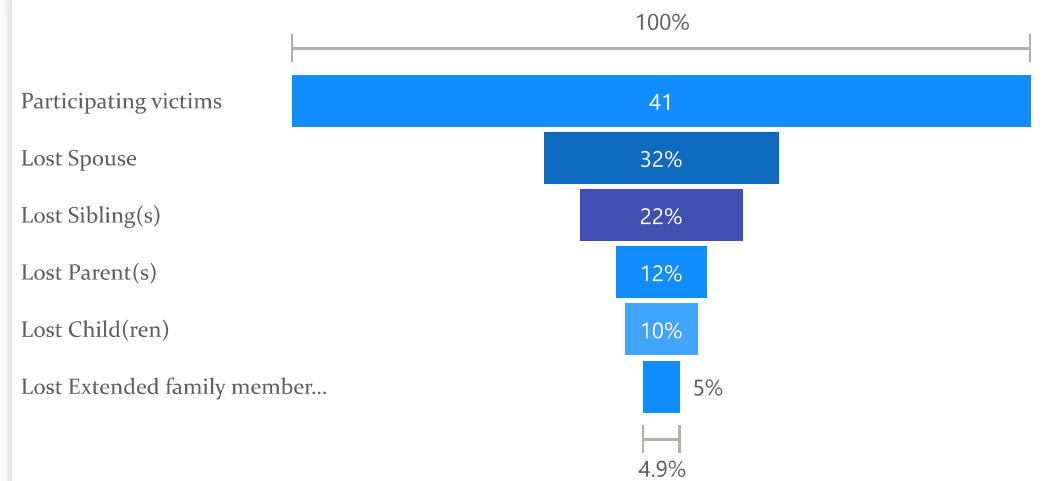
"Fear/Anxiety" includes symptoms such as fear, anxiety, panic, stress, hypertension due to stress.

"Vulnerability" includes symptoms such as feeling unsafe, mental fragility, dependence, isolation or social rejection, feeling exposed or unprotected.

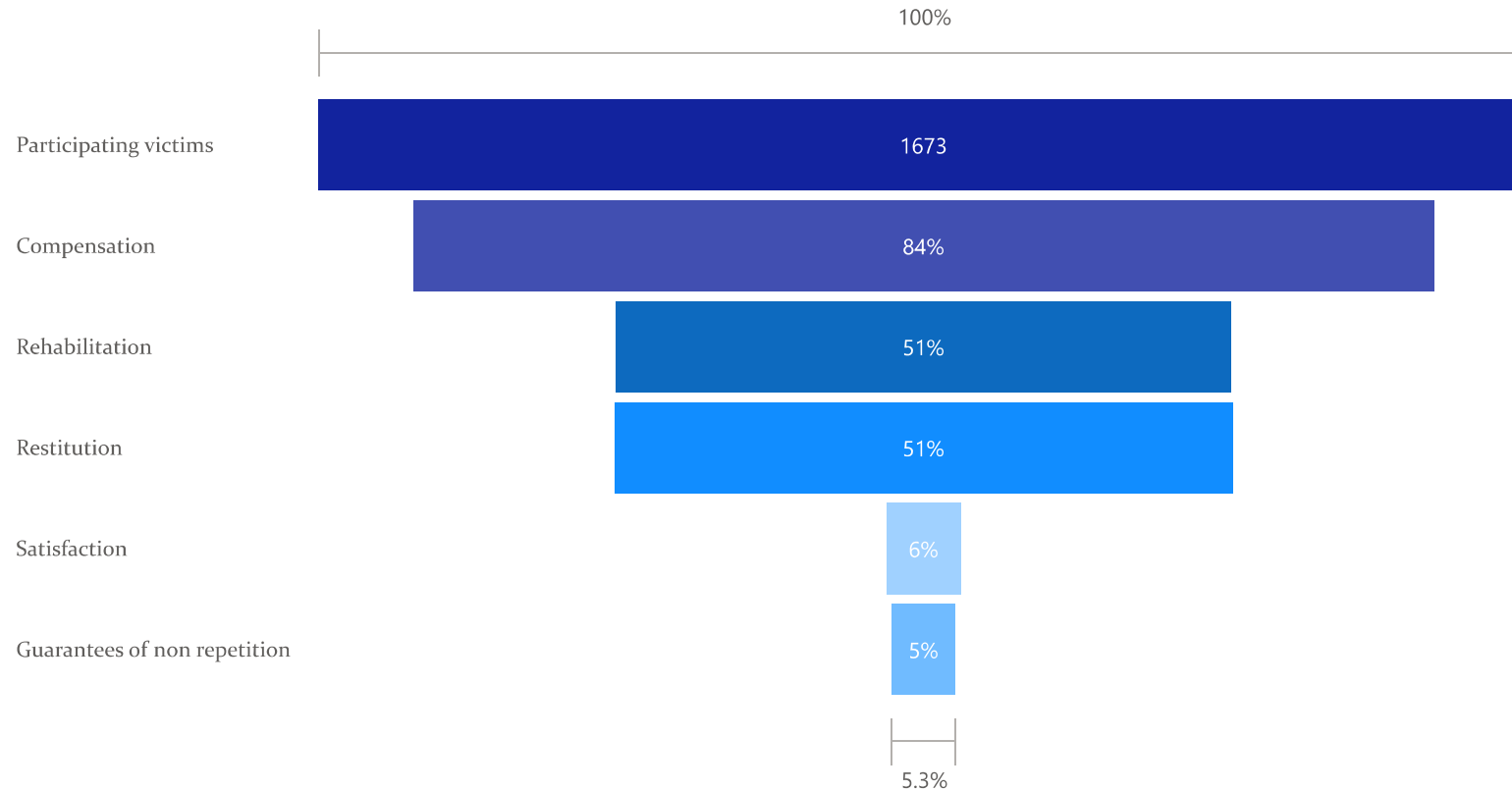
"Sleeping disorders" include symptoms such as insomnia, nightmares, inability to sleep and frequent awakenings.

"Eating disorders" include symptoms such as loss of appetite, vomiting, stomach pain and inability to eat.

Memory loss includes symptoms such as forgetfulness, confusion and concentration problems.

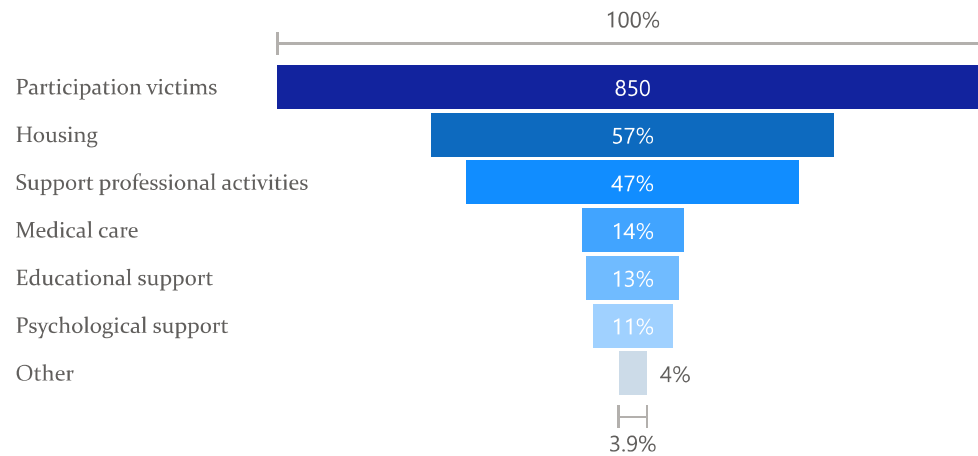


Overview reparation measures requested - all events

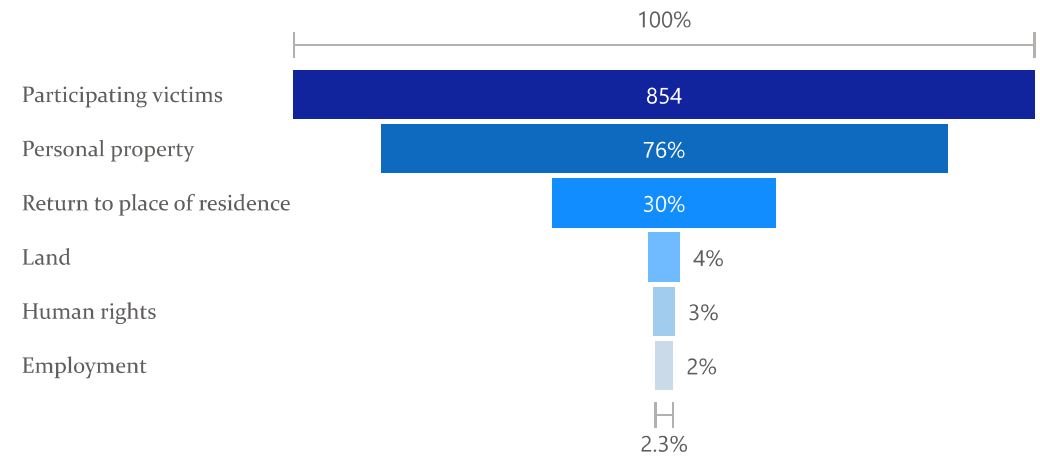
For the category “Compensation,” participating victims specify in approximately 20% of the requests the amount sought and the type of compensation they are requesting, including compensation for psychological and/or physical harm, loss of property or land, loss of wages or income, and the loss of relatives.

For the category “Guarantees of Non-Repetition,” participating victims indicate measures such as preventing and monitoring social conflicts, implementing civic education initiatives, reforming laws and ensuring effective civilian oversight of military and security forces.
