Dear Executive Director,

I write to follow-up on the Defence's fundraising activities in favour of victims in Darfur.

[REDACTED] This meeting was the opportunity for an extremely positive and fruitful exchange, during which the Defence clarified the nature and purpose of its solicitation to address voluntary donations to the Trust Fund for Victims in favour of victims in Darfur, Sudan. The Defence clarified that its role in this matter was limited to facilitating contacts with the Trust Fund for Victims to which donations should exclusively be addressed.

[REDACTED] kindly confirmed his willingness to take action on the Defence's solicitation upon receipt of a letter from the Trust Fund for Victims inviting [REDACTED] in favour of Darfur victims. That letter will place him in a position to submit that request to its capital for appropriate consideration.

[REDACTED] you without waiting, so that the Trust Fund for Victims confirms with the [REDACTED] its readiness to receive ear-marked donations in favour of the victims in Darfur, Sudan.
