Dear colleagues,

The Chamber refers to the Prosecution's email of 17 March 2026 requesting an extension of page limit for the Pre-Confirmation Brief from 120 pages to 150 pages.

The Chamber notes that, in their respective responses sent via email on 18 March 2026, the OPCV indicates it has no objection, and the Defence takes no position and leaves the matter to the Chamber.

At the outset, the Chamber recalls that the standard page limit for Pre-Confirmation Brief under Regulation 38(1) of the Regulations of the Court (the 'Regulations') is 120 pages. The Chamber notes the Prosecution submission that the 30-page extension is justified by exceptional circumstances because 'a more detailed articulation of the Prosecution's case and evidence will assist the Chamber, as well as the Parties and Participants, in their preparation for the confirmation hearing'. Having regard to the submissions received, the Chamber is satisfied that pursuant to Regulation 37(2) of the Regulations there are exceptional circumstances warranting the extension of page limit sought for the Pre-Confirmation Brief.

The Chamber accordingly grants the Prosecution request and extends the page limit for the Pre-Confirmation Brief to 150 pages.
