Dear colleagues,

The EI Hishri Defence notes the information provided by the Registry in its email of Friday, 5 June 2026 at 18:44, according to which the State of Libya was only made aware of the Addendum to our Jurisdiction Challenge (ICC-01/11-01/25-119-Conf) on 4 June 2026. It follows that Libya's Observations on the Challenge to the Jurisdiction of the Court (ICC-01/11-01/25-129+Conf-Anx) dated 3 June 2026 could not have taken the Addendum into consideration.

We do not yet know whether or by when Libya intends to file any additional Observations to our Addendum.

The Defence is eager to respond to Libya's Observations on the Challenge to the Jurisdiction of the Court. We may also wish to respond to any additional Observations. We will of course comply with any direction made by the Chamber, but our preference, in the interests of efficiency, would be to file one consolidated response to both sets of Observations. This would allow us to cross-reference both sets of Observations in a single filing. We wonder, therefore, if the Pre-Trial Chamber may be minded to direct Libya to indicate whether it intends to file any additional Observations to our Addendum within a reasonable time before our 16:00 deadline this Friday.

If Libya has no such intention, we will file our response on Friday as per the Chamber's directions. If Libya indicates an intention to file additional Observations, we would respectfully request that the Pre-Trial Chamber grant us an extension to file a consolidated response no later than two days after receipt of Libya's additional Observations.

We thank the Pre-Trial Chamber for its consideration.
