Information not contained in the detention record	Category A1: Under seal	Category A2: Confidential
	- possible security breaches including escape attempts; - reports of the inspecting authority; - specific measures at the Host Prison, - information derived from any type of communications regime in place and which may reveal certain information related to the staff of the Detention centre and of the Registry.	- specific information related to non-privileged visits and communications; - information relating to the monitoring of communications which do not reveal sensitive information about the management of the detention centre, custodial staff or Registry staff, or which might relate to the 'private life' of a detained person.
Information in the detention record	Category B1: Confidential	Category B2: Public
	- information relating to the privacy of certain aspects of the detention regime of a detained person: matters related to spiritual welfare, health and safety, medical record (regulation 156 of the RoR); - log of privileged visits and correspondence and, any measures related to cell monitoring (regulation 196 of the RoR).	<i>inter alia:</i> - warrant of arrest; - document containing the charges, the date and time of admission, the name of the counsel, the time spent in custody (regulation 189 (b), (d), (e) and (g)).
