Represented by Mr Jérôme-Dieudonné GBOBOUKO, advocate with right of audience before the Bangui Appeals Court, whose office is located at Place de la République, Immeuble Nation Link Telecom, B.P. 220, Bangui, Central African Republic; which Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo chooses as his address for service for the purposes of these proceedings;

Hereby give formal notice of the filing of an application for reversal of the decision partially setting aside the dismissal of the charges and ordering the severance of the proceedings and committal for trial before the *Cour Criminelle*, rendered on 16 December 2004 by the Indictments Chamber of the Bangui Appeals Court, roll No. 021, year 2004.

This Application, based on the relevant articles of Organic Law No. 95.0011 of 23 December 2005 on the Organisation and Functioning of the Court of Cassation, in particular articles 19, 20, 21, 23 *et seq*, is entered against the impugned decision in its entirety, on grounds that will be duly set out in a separate brief within the time limits prescribed by law.
