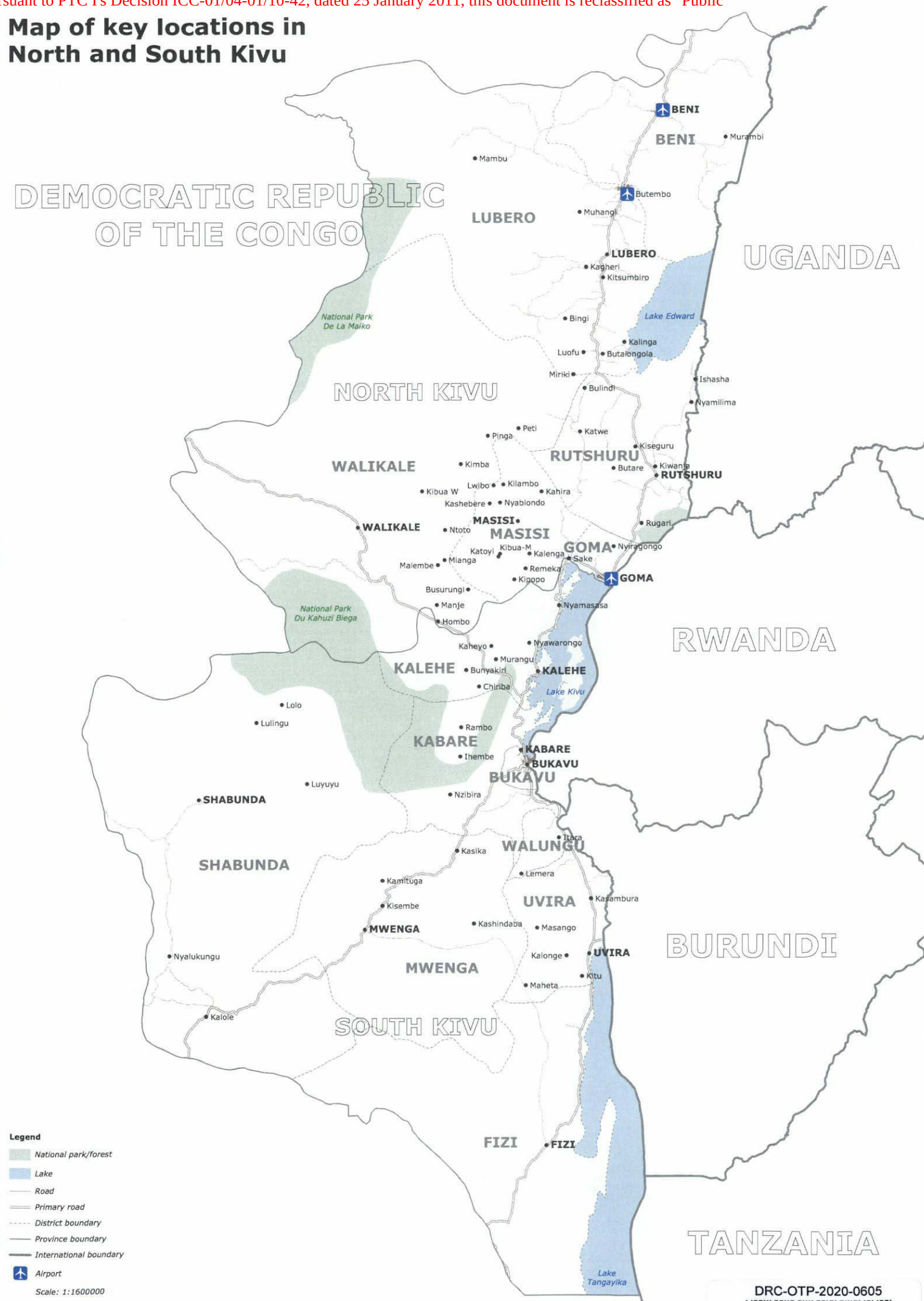

Pinga: 14 February 2009
FDLR combatants allegedly kill a village chief and commit 28 rapes.

Miriki: February 2009
FDLR combatants allegedly force three boys to rape three girls.

Katoyi & Kibua: late January 2009
Many civilians allegedly killed by FDLR and in the cross-fire with FARDC-RDF.

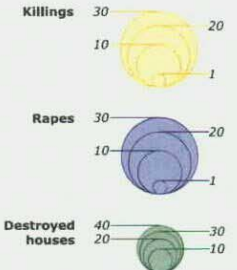
Remeka: end of January 2009
FDLR combatants allegedly abduct at least a dozen women and killed dozens of civilians, including nine females who resisted rape.

Malembe, Mianga and Busurungi: 30 January 2009
FDLR combatants allegedly kill over 36 civilians in the three villages.

Kipopo: 13 February 2009
FDLR combatants allegedly burn 100 houses and kill many people.

Busheke: late January 2009
FDLR combatants allegedly kill 14 civilians, including 12 women who were also raped.

Key for FDLR crime data
Circle area is proportional to average number of killings, rapes or destroyed houses. For visual clarity and to account for the difference in figures, killings and rapes circle area has been multiplied by seven, while destroyed houses circle area has been multiplied by two.
