Steps taken to date

Detailed analysis of all work done to date by current counsel, including submissions, appearances, communications with the Registry etc	27 July
Preparation and distribution of document informing counsel of the process for common legal representation and requesting expression of interest	11 July
Review of expressions of interest for initial shortlisting	29 July
Preparation and sending of follow-up questions to distribute to shortlisted counsel	1 August
Preparation of assessment/marking guide for follow-up questions	3 August
Letters drafted and sent to current counsel identifying areas of potential concern	3 August
Preparation of filing for 8 August deadline	4 August

Assessment of responses sent by shortlisted counsel to follow-up questions	1 day	4 August
Assessment of responses sent by current counsel to letters identifying areas of potential concern (after responses are received on 5 August)	1 days	8 August
Contacting of candidates selected for interviews (including from among current counsel following receipt of their responses) and arranging of schedule for interviews	1 day	9 August
Conduct of interviews	3 days	12 August
Deliberations of panel and final decision	1 day	13 August
Drafting and finalization of internal Registry panel report	3 days	18 August
Finalization and filing of report to Chamber for final deadline, explaining in full the steps taken and the reasons for the recommendation made	1 week	25 August
