The Registry of the International Criminal Court presents its compliments to the Embassy of the Republic of Kenya to the Kingdom of the Netherlands and has the honour to refer to its note verbale (Ref: NV/2013/3154/ab/ak) dated 19 December 2013 requesting an update on a request for cooperation in the case of *the Prosecutor v. Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta* (ICC-01/09-02/11) for onward transmission to the relevant authorities of the Republic of Kenya.

In the above-mentioned note verbale, the Registry requested the competent authorities of the Republic of Kenya to provide information on the questions raised in its note verbale (Ref: NV/DCS/2012/125/MD/vw) dated 28 May 2012 and to update the Registry on the efforts undertaken by the competent authorities in 2013 to execute the Court's request for cooperation. In this regard, the Registry also kindly requests the authorities of the Republic of Kenya to confirm that the items on the "List of alleged property and assets – Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta" transmitted in note verbales sent on 8 April 2011 (Ref: NV/2011/1041/ior/ab/gb/SA) and on 28 December 2012 (Ref: NV/2012/1716/ab/ak/JW) belong to H.E. Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta and enquires whether any of the items on the list have been frozen or seized by the authorities of the Republic of Kenya so far.

The Registry was to file a report to the Chamber and therefore invited the competent authorities of the Republic of Kenya to send their reply by 17 January 2014. On 16 January 2014, the Registry received an update from the Office of the Attorney General in another case. For this reason, the Registry requests the competent authorities of the Republic of Kenya to send their reply concerning this request for cooperation by 24 February 2014 and to enter into consultations with the Court should they identify problems which may impede or prevent the execution of the request for cooperation in accordance with article 97 of the Rome Statute.
