Dear Trial Chamber IX,

pursuant to Trial Chamber's Decision # 449 (30.05.2016), the Prosecution will no later than on 6 September 2016 file its Pre-Trial Brief, List of Evidence, Final List of Prosecution Witnesses and Final Summaries of Anticipated Testimony.

For all these documents, the Prosecution respectfully requests the Trial Chamber to lift or, alternatively, extend the page limit of 20 pages prescribed by Regulation 37(1) of the Regulations of the Court.

The Pre-Trial Brief will contain detailed submissions on facts, law and evidence for all 70 counts of the Prosecution's case against Dominic Ongwen. In light of this, the Prosecution requests that the page limit for it be extended to 300 pages.

The Finalized Summaries of Anticipated Witness Testimony will contain summaries of 69 witnesses. These are (for the most part) updated provisional summaries the Prosecution has already filed in the case. They will altogether amount to approximately 400 pages. The Prosecution is unable to predict the length in pages of its LOE, which will contain approximately 5000 items.

For reasons of efficiency and noting that the Chamber had on a previous occasion authorized extension of page limit via email, the Prosecution makes this request through email communication. Should the Trial Chamber however consider that a formal filing is necessary, the Prosecution will act accordingly.

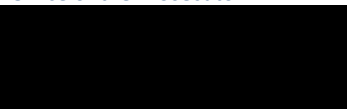
