By way of follow-up to the “Decision Concerning 610 Victim Applications (Registry Report ICC-02/04-01/15-544) and 1183 Victim Applications (Registry Report ICC-02/04-01/15-556)” (filing number ICC-02/04-01/15-586), the Single Judge notes that the Prosecution has identified 25 victims whose applications were transmitted by way of the Registry’s third report (ICC-02/04-01/15-556), who are also Prosecution witnesses (see paras 10-11 of “Prosecution’s observations on 1183 victim applications for participation, notified on 7 October 2016”, ICC-02/04-01/15-576).

Thus, the identities of these applicants have already been disclosed to the Defence. Accordingly, the Single Judge, acting pursuant to Regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court, directs the Registry to reclassify the unredacted versions of these applications as confidential.
