Dear Trial Chamber IX,

Pursuant to Regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court, the Defence for Dominic Ongwen respectfully requests an extension of the time limit to respond to Prosecution filing ICC-02/04-01/15-654, "Prosecution's request to submit 1006 items of evidence from the 'bar table'". The Defence requests three (3) weeks to respond to the filing (*i.e.* a due date of 7 February 2017 at 16h00 CET).

The Prosecution filing contains 1006 items for submission, which are grouped into 10 different categories. Unlike the previous BTM, these categories are not interrelated. Considering the volume of the items requested to be submitted, and the wide range of topics these items cover, the Defence submits that it has demonstrated good cause for an extension of the time limit as required by Regulation 35(2) of the RoC.

The Defence has talked to the Prosecution and both Legal Representatives for Victims, and all stated that they do not oppose the request.
