Please see below for guidance from the Chamber on how documents are to be referenced in court during the hearing. Best, [REDACTED] on behalf of Trial Chamber IX

The first time a document is referenced during the hearing, the whole ERN and binder tab must be referenced (e.g. 'Tab 1 of the Binder, UGA-OTP-0270-0004').

For every subsequent reference to the entire document, the binder tab or other clearly identifiable short form is sufficient (e.g. 'Tab 1' or 'The Expert Report') .

For every reference to a specific page of a document, the last four digits must be used (e.g. 'at page 0018'). When referencing a specific page the first time a document is referenced, the full ERN, binder tab, and specific page must be referenced (e.g. 'Tab 1 of the Binder, UGA-0270-0004, at 0018').
