- p. 7 lines 11-16 – general discussion of what happened to civilians during the Pajule attack as well as that some people (LRA) killed civilians and some did not

T-54

- p. 26 line 22 – p. 28 line 1 - discussion of the meaning of the word Lapwony, [REDACTED]

T-55

- p. 8 line 9 – p. 9 line 3 – discussion of Ongwen’s call sign and how people on the radio recognised him
- p. 53 line 16 - p. 56 line 5 – the witness’s general acknowledgement that he participated in the Opit attack and the discussion of the Opit attack, whether Ongwen was in sickbay during that attack, and Ongwen’s direct subordinates at the time of the attack
- p.65 line 21 – p. 67 line 6 – discussion of Odhiambo, Ongwen’s affiliation within the LRA and general information about the witness’s escape

- p. 67 line 19 – p. 68 line 3 – general information about the witness's escape
