Dear Counsel:

In request 862, the Prosecution identifies five victim applications related to P-269 and P-252: a/06902/15, a/01094/16, a/01205/16, a/01064/16 and a/00820/16. Given that these are the next two witnesses expected to testify, the Chamber shortened the response deadline for these five applications to 13:00 today (Email from Trial Chamber IX Communications, 12 June 2017 at 09:34).

The Defence does not oppose the relief sought, but both LRV teams oppose the provision of lesser redacted applications from these victims (Email from the Defence, 12 June 2017 at 12:15; Email from the OPCV, 12 June 2017 at 12:54 (with redacted version sent at 13:09); Email from the LRVs, 12 June 2017 at 12:58 and 13:07). The Prosecution also requested leave to reply to one point made in the *ex parte* observations made by the OPCV on the application of victim a/06902/15, and this request is opposed by the OPCV (Email from the Prosecution, 12 June 2017 at 13:21; Email from the OPCV, 12 June 2017 at 13:30).

In the interest of facilitating an expeditious examination of P-269 and P-252, the Chamber indicates now that the Prosecution's request is granted in respect of these five applications. The reasons for this decision will follow in the forthcoming decision on request 862. Given that the Prosecution's request in relation to victim a/06902/15 is granted, the Chamber dismisses its request for leave to reply as moot.

Care must be taken when using the information contained in these applications. In particular, any use of the applications of a/06902/15 or a/01094/16 must not [REDACTED].
