Dear Trial Chamber IX,

During the upcoming evidentiary blocks, dual status individuals P-0366, P-0374 and P-0199 will testify by video-link. Said individuals are represented by the CLR team [REDACTED] (Field Counsel) will follow the hearings at the video link location in Kampala and she will question the witnesses, if authorised.

In these circumstances, as for the past, I am respectfully requesting the Chamber to instruct the Registry to make the necessary arrangements for [REDACTED] to follow the hearings from the same location of the witnesses.
