Dear Counsel and Registry:

For PCV-1, the Chamber recognises as formally submitted the items submitted by the Common Legal Representatives for Victims (Email from the CLRV, 15 May 2018, at 08:43), confirming that the witness's report is introduced by virtue of the procedural pre-requisites of Rule 68(3) of the Rules being satisfied. It is noted that the Chamber rejected a Defence request to exclude parts of PCV-1's report (T-175, page 2 line 17 to page 8 line 16, *ruled upon at* page 11 line 14 to page 13 line 3). As stated at the end of this ruling, the Chamber will defer consideration of the Defence arguments falling under the standard evidentiary criteria until deliberating its judgment (*as per the general approach in* Initial Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings, 13 July 2016, ICC-02/04-01/15-497, paras 24-25).

It is also noted that the Defence does not formally submit any items of evidence following this witness's testimony (Email from the LRV, 14 May 2018 at 18:48).
