 Dear colleagues in the Registry,

The Chamber notes that some of the proposed redactions for the Decision on Submitted Materials for D-81 are disputed. It takes note of the additional redactions proposed by the Prosecution (email from the Prosecution on 14 October 2019, 16:05 with an attachment including the requested redactions) and the response by the Defence (email from the Defence on 16 October 2019, at 09:37).

The Chamber considers that there is no justification to redact the information forming part of the disagreement. First, D-81 testified publicly – there are no considerations in regard of his safety which could justify the redactions. Second, with regard to P-0006, the Chamber does not consider that the information in question reveals the identity of the witness.

Accordingly, the disputed parts of the Prosecution's proposal are not to be redacted. The parts which were not disputed by the Defence (the name of the woman and the police file record number) are still to be redacted.

Dear Trial Chamber IX,

As for Annexes I-VI and Annexes VIII-XIV the Defence has no requests.

The Defence disputes the majority of the redaction requests for **Annex VII** from the Prosecution.

To begin, the Defence agrees that the name [REDACTED] should be redacted. It is redacted in ICC-02/04-01/15-T-140-Red2 and the Defence can think of no compelling reason to lift that redaction.

As to the information about the date of the interrogation of D-0081 by the UPDF, the witness testified without protective measures and the date of the report is without consequence. There is no reason for the date to be redacted.

As for the information about the date range of the reports by the Uganda Police, the information about the date in which P-0006 gave her statement to the Ugandan Police is public in ICC-02/04-01/15-T-140-Red2. There is no reason to hide the date range.

As for the timing of the interviews, again, the Defence disputes the necessity of the redaction requests. These dates, times and time frames do not identify any of the witnesses who received ICPMs.

As for the the case name [REDACTED] while the Defence avers that it is unnecessary to redact this, the Defence does not mind if this redaction is put in place.
