**The Palestinian Federation of Women Action Committees
call for an international campaign to release Palestinian children and women from
the Israeli occupation prisons**

1. The Palestinian Federation of Women Action Committees called for the launching of an urgent international campaign to release Palestinian children and women in the prisons of the Israeli occupation, while the world stands united to find all health and environmental measures to confront the pandemic of the Corona Virus - Covid 19, which now threatens all of humanity, It should be noted that there are about 200 Palestinian children and 43 Palestinian women and girls still languishing in the occupation prisons, including mothers, patients and the elderly, in light of the very fragile health, humanitarian and environmental conditions and convenient for an outbreak of the Corona virus, which will definitely endanger their lives taking into account the rapid spread of the disease and the lack of the ability of global health systems to contain the scale of this pandemic outbreak, so how will the situation be in the Israeli occupation prisons, which by their naturally racist policies that do not provide the bare minimum requirements for a human life and a healthy environment ?

2. The Palestinian Federation of Women Action Committees called on the Ministry of Palestinian Women's Affairs, the General Union of Palestinian Women, women's institutions and centers, human rights organizations, and the Prisoners 'Affairs organization in Palestine to adopt this campaign and work to spread it, expand it, and internationalize it, and to invite the International Women's Democratic Union and the Euro-Mediterranean Women Initiative , The Arab Women Union and other regional and international feminist institutions to join this campaign, to address the Secretary-General of the United Nations, the Human Rights Council and other international bodies to pressure the government of Israel and its demand for the release of children and Palestinian women whose lives are threatened by the conditions in which they live in according to the WHO warnings and instructions to prevent Corona virus.

3. The Palestinian Federation of Women Action Committees confirmed that it will continue to work towards launching this international campaign to pressure the release of Palestinian children and women through its membership and role in the General Union of Women and the Palestinian Women's Movement and its membership in the International Women's Democratic Union and the Euro-Mediterranean Women's Initiative and its relationship with a number of regional networks. To enable and empower children and women who are in prisons to go back and be around their families, just as all the families of the world are at this difficult time in history.
