Dear Defence,

The Chamber notes the Request pursuant to Regulation 37 of the Regulation of the Court.

The reasons provided in the email – reference to human rights concerned and the content of the anticipated filing (paid sick leave and contract law) – are too generic and unspecific to constitute exceptional circumstances pursuant to Regulation 37(2) of the Regulations of the Court and justify an extension of 10 pages.

However, having regard to Article 64(2) of the Statute, the Chamber grants an additional 5 pages for the anticipated filing in order to enable the Defence to fully present its arguments.

Dear Trial Chamber IX,

Pursuant to Regulation 37(2) of the Regulations of the Court, I respectfully request a page limit increase in a forthcoming request for review of a decision pursuant to Regulation 135(2) of the Regulations of the Registry. I ask for an additional 10 pages.

The request for review shall deal with the fundamental right of a person being allowed to have reasonable paid sick leave, the human rights concerned, contract law, etc., which is why I am not sure if the request for review shall make it within the 20 page limit required by Regulation 37(1) of the RoC.

The request for review, as it deals with health issues, shall be filed *ex parte*, but a public redacted version shall be made available within 24 hours of the original pleading.
