Dear colleagues of Trial Chamber X,

On behalf of the Registry I bring your kind attention to the message below and would be very grateful if you could please convey it to the Judges for their consideration.

The Registry has invited two designated experts to visit the Court and the Detention Centre in the context of an inquiry into the provision and pricing of food at the Detention Centre and food related matters. These experts are contracted by the Registry for the purposes of this inquiry and preparing a report to the Registrar. They are visiting the Court and the Detention Centre this week.

In this context, the Registry would like to inform the Chamber that the designated experts have expressed their wish to meet with each detained person to discuss food related matters. In this regard and considering that the experts may be considered as representatives of the Registry for the purposes of Regulations 180(1) and 183(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, the Registry intends to inform the detained persons of this request and to equally inform their Defence teams of this request as before the experts visit any detained person, each detained person would first need to confirm their willingness to speak to the experts.

In this context, and prior to organizing any meetings between the experts and Mr Al Hassan, in the presence of a representative of the Office of the Director of the

Division of Judicial Services, and considering that Mr Al Hassan is under restrictions on contact, the Registry kindly seeks clarification with the Chamber that, should Mr Al Hassan consent to the visit, the contact with the experts is compatible with the said restrictions.
