Based on the result of language proficiency assessments conducted by the Language Services Section (LSS), the Registry concludes that Mr Said is able to read and understand the main points of a relatively complex text such as a witness statement written in French.

The Registry further concludes that Mr Said has a higher level of spoken Sango than French and that he prefers to express himself orally in Sango. If the Chamber might nonetheless deem it necessary, the LSS could undertake the translation of a limited volume of written documents into Sango by means of Sango audio recordings.
