Dear Trial Chamber X, dear Colleagues,

The VPRS would like to inform you that among the Group A applications transmitted today (18 December 2020, ICC-01/12-01/18-1214) in the *Al Hassan* case, two applicants have been identified as OTP witnesses: a/35011/16 (P-0542) and a/50906/20 (P-0565).

Applicant a/35011/16 is among the seven applications recently identified by the VPRS as complete and inside the scope of the *Al Hassan* case, and following the Chamber's clarification of 24 November 2020. This application has been transmitted as part of the Group A applications. As far as VPRS is aware, this applicant has not yet testified and may testify in April 2021.

Applicant a/50906/20 was met by a representative of VPRS following the Chamber's instruction of 29 November 2020 (email from Trial Chamber X Communication, 29 November 2020, 12:38). This applicant has already testified before the Chamber.

The VPRS notes the Single Judge's decision of 20 December 2019 instructing the Registry to 1) liaise with the Prosecutor and LRVs in order to identify dual status witnesses amongst the victims participating in the *Al Hassan* proceedings; and 2) transmit to the Prosecution unredacted versions of the victim applications of those individuals, if any, together with any supporting documents (ICC-01/12-01/18-536, para. 11, a. and b.).

The VPRS notes that applicants a/35011/16 and a/50906/20 are not participating victims yet, but may become so if the Chamber grants the request for victim status. The VPRS will transmit these applications to the Prosecutor in their original version as soon as the Chamber issues a decision on their victim status, or at any point prior to that if the Chamber so orders.
