This referral is made in coordination with a group of States Parties to the Rome Statute and it was already announced yesterday by the Embassy of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland in The Netherlands.

The Embassy of Colombia to the Kingdom of the Netherlands makes this referral acting under Articles 13(a) and 14(1), of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court. It also takes into account two declarations submitted by the Government of Ukraine, acting under Article 12(3), accepting the International Criminal Court's jurisdiction with respect to alleged acts committed on its own territory within the time period 21 November 2013 to 22 February 2014, and since 20 February 2014, respectively.

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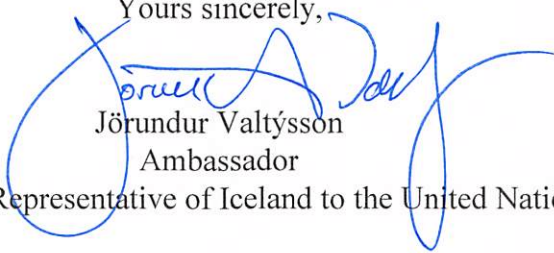

NOTE VERBALE

The Embassy of the Kingdom of Spain presents its compliments to the Office of the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court and would like to present the following State Party Referral under Article 14 of the Rome Statute:

The Kingdom of Spain,

Noting Ukraine's acceptance of the International Criminal Court's jurisdiction, pursuant to article 12, paragraph 3, of the Rome Statute;

Noting the first declaration lodged by the Government of Ukraine accepted the Court's jurisdiction with respect to alleged acts committed on the territory of Ukraine within the time period 21 November 2013 to 22 February 2014; and in the second declaration accepted the Court's jurisdiction with respect to alleged acts committed on Ukrainian territory since 20 February 2014;

Noting that a State's acceptance of the International Criminal Court's jurisdiction by means of a declaration enables the Court, pursuant to article 12(2) of the Rome Statute, to exercise its jurisdiction over any alleged acts of war crimes, crimes against humanity or genocide committed on that State's territory or by its nationals;

Desiring to give effect to the exercise of the Court's jurisdiction with respect to the Situation in Ukraine;

Acting pursuant to article 13, paragraph a, and article 14, paragraph 1, of the Rome Statute;

Decides to refer the Situation in Ukraine to the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court for the purpose of requesting the Prosecutor to investigate any acts of war crimes, crimes against humanity and genocide alleged to have occurred on the territory of Ukraine from 21 November 2013 onwards, including any allegations of current and ongoing crimes occurring throughout the whole Ukrainian territory, thereby requesting the Court to exercise its jurisdiction with respect to the jurisdictional scope accepted by Ukraine.

The Embassy of Spain avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Office of the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court the assurances of its highest consideration. *CF*
