Dear Counsels,
Dear colleagues,

The Single Judge expresses her appreciation for the parties and participants' input in context of preparing public versions of email rulings to be put on the record.

The Single Judge instructs the Registry to proceed with the preparation of the reports, putting on the public record of the case redacted versions of the email rulings as proposed by the Registry with any further uncontested redactions suggested by the parties and participants. Moreover, the Single Judge finds it appropriate to provide complementary guidance:

First, the Single Judge agrees with the Defence that no further redaction need to be applied to email ruling no. 7 attached to email of 14 June 2021 at 11:26, contrary to what was proposed by the Registry.

Second, she is of the view that the following email rulings should be filed on the public record of the case with additional redactions:

Third, the Single Judge grants all the Prosecution's uncontested requests for certain email rulings to remain 'confidential'. The Single Judge adds that three of these emails ([REDACTED])

[REDACTED] should maintain their initial classification, that is ex parte only available to the Prosecution.

Fourth, the Single Judge instructs the Defence to provide directly to the Chamber its proposals for redactions to email rulings no. 4, 6, 7 and 8 attached to email of 14 June 2021 at 09:37, irrespective of whether or not VWS has provided its input.

Sixth, the Single Judge recalls her prior instruction that email ruling no. 5 attached to email of 14 June 2021 at 10:58 can be filed on the public record of the case with the redactions proposed by the Registry (see email from the Single Judge on 18 June 2021 at 8:21)

Finally, the Single Judge reiterates her appreciation of the way this process was undertaken, but would welcome any proposal by the Registry to increase efficiency for the preparation of upcoming reports (including to rely on a system other than emails exchanges).
